Devotional: Ask God for Divine Wisdom

Devotional: Generosity Invites God's Blessings

It can feel counterintuitive to give when finances are tight, but Scripture teaches generosity unlocks God's abundant blessings. Giving reflects our trust that God is the ultimate provider and initiates a cycle of grace and favor.

This principle applies broadly — whether through tithing, helping a coworker in need, or sharing resources. Generosity not only blesses others, but refreshes and prospers the giver spiritually and often financially.

Today, consider how you can cultivate a generous heart at work and in your community. Trust that God will reward your cheerful giving with breakthroughs you might not anticipate.
