#### Devotional: Empowered by God's Strength for Health Challenges

Day 2: The Honoring God with Our Bodies

#### Devotional: Caring for Your Body as God's Sacred Temple

God's Word identifies your body as a sacred temple where His Spirit dwells. This means caring for your physical health is not just a personal choice but an act of worship. - Exodus 33:14 "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."







#### Devotional: Receiving Rest and Renewal in Jesus' Presence

Managing metabolic syndrome can bring physical exhaustion and emotional weariness. But Jesus invites us to find true rest in Him. **Matthew 11:28** is a promise for those burdened by health or life's pressures to come and receive refreshing rest that recharges body and soul.

Rest is essential—not just physical sleep but spiritual renewal. When overwhelmed by dietary restrictions, medication routines, or lifestyle changes, pause and invite God's peace. He leads us beside still waters to soothe our spirits.

Today, practice resting in God's presence and acknowledge He carries your burdens. Trust His timing and pace for your healing journey.

# Devotional: Harnessing Spiritual Self-Control for Wellness

Walking a path of healing involves discipline, especially with diet, exercise, and medication. Spiritual self-control — a fruit of the Holy Spirit — helps govern our desires and decisions for long-term health benefits.

Galatians 5:22–23 lists self-control alongside love, patience, and kindness. When you feel tempted to give in to unhealthy habits, remember that practicing discipline nurtures both your body and spirit.

Like Paul in *1 Corinthians 9:27*, training your body daily can be an act of worship. Ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen your resolve and remind you that self-control builds resilience to metabolic challenges.

#### Devotional: Relying on God's Faithful Provision

Sometimes battling metabolic syndrome brings fear about resources: healthy food costs, medical bills, or feeling helpless. Yet God invites us to trust His abundant provision in Psalm 34:10, promising those who seek Him will lack no good thing.

**Philippians 4:19** reminds us that God supplies our needs from His glorious riches. Even when circumstances feel tight, God's provision is faithful.

Today, focus on seeking God first, believing He will provide guidance, strength, and resources to overcome health challenges. His provision might come in unexpected forms — encouragement, access to care, or inner peace.

# Devotional: Finding Strength in Community and Encouragement

#### Devotional: Walking Forward in God's Healing Hope
