Day 1: Planting Seeds of Faith

Devotional: Trusting God Begins with Belief

Faith is the foundation for receiving your financial miracle. Jesus teaches us in Mark 11:24 to believe *that we have already received* what we ask for in prayer. It's not a wish or hopeful thinking but confident trust rooted in God's character. When you pray for provision, don't focus on the scarcity but on God's limitless power and generosity.

Devotional: Learning to Wait Patiently on God

Waiting on God's provision can feel challenging, but His timing is perfect.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us that God orchestrates the timing of every season in our lives. When praying for a financial miracle, patience is not passive resignation; instead, it is active trust in God's plan.

Isaiah 40:31 encourages those who place their hope in the LORD will find renewed strength. Waiting on God renews our faith muscles and deepens our relationship with Him. It is in these waiting seasons that God prepares blessings and tests our trust.

Psalm 34:4 offers a testimony of God's deliverance from fear. When we seek the Lord sincerely, He responds and brings peace that conquers anxiety.
