Your Verse

2 Corinthians 12:9 - "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 34:18 "The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."
- Isaiah 40:29 "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."







Devotional: God's Power Shines Through Our Weakness

Depression can make us feel fragile, exhausted, and powerless, especially when the daily demands of a job persist relentlessly. On days when you feel utterly weak, these words from **2 Corinthians 12:9** remind us that God's power shines brightest through our vulnerability. Recognizing our limitations does not mean failure; rather, it opens the door for God's grace to sustain and uplift us.

When work becomes overwhelming, and the heaviness of depression weighs on your heart, remember that God is near to those broken in spirit (*Psalm 34:18*).

Embrace your weakness as an invitation to rely on God more deeply. He promises to renew your strength — not by removing the struggle immediately but by empowering you to endure it with hope and perseverance. You are not alone in this fight, and your value transcends how you perform at the workplace. Take a moment to breathe, invite God's presence into your feelings, and lean into his grace.

Prayer for Today

Heavenly Father, in my moments of weakness and despair, help me to remember that Your grace is enough. Please strengthen me when I feel broken and weary. Remind me that Your power rests in my weakness and give me the courage to keep moving forward each day. Comfort my heart, renew my spirit, and guide me through my work challenges with hope and peace. I surrender my struggles to You, trusting in Your steadfast love. *Amen.*

















Your Verse

Colossians 3:23 – "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters."

Supporting Scriptures

- Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."
- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."







Devotional: Work Wholeheartedly as Serving the Lord

When depression clouds your mind, you might question your worth or feel like you're just going through the motions at work. The Bible invites you to redefine success by anchoring your purpose in God rather than human approval. **Colossians 3:23** challenges us to work wholeheartedly as if serving the Lord himself — not merely to earn praise or meet expectations.

This perspective frees you from the pressure to be 'perfect' and anchors your identity on God's eternal plan. You are His masterpiece, created to fulfill specific good works (*Ephesians 2:10*), even if those works seem small or invisible right now. In times of exhaustion, Jesus extends an open invitation to come to Him for rest (*Matthew 11:28*).

Let your work become a sacred offering rather than a burdensome task. When you align your daily efforts with God's purpose, you strengthen your spirit and find deeper meaning beyond productivity metrics and workplace stress. Remember, your ultimate value is found in serving God, not in the imperfect moments or struggles at your job.

Prayer for Today

Lord Jesus, thank You for reminding me to work as though I serve You, not humans. When I feel burdened or inadequate, grant me the peace to rest in Your love and the strength to continue my work with purpose. Help me remember that my worth is found in You, not my performance, and guide my steps as I seek to fulfill the good works You have prepared for me. *Amen.*



















Your Verse

Philippians 4:6-7 – "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 Peter 5:7 "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you."
- Psalm 55:22 "Cast your cares on the LORD and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken."







Devotional: Casting Work Anxiety on God Through Prayer

Depression often brings waves of anxiety, especially around work — whether it's fear of failure, judgment, or burnout. Philippians 4:6–7 offers a clear prescription: instead of succumbing to worry, bring your concerns to God through prayer and thanksgiving.

Prayer is a powerful weapon against anxiety. It transfers the weight from your shoulders to God's loving hands. When you pour out your heart in honest conversation with Him, His peace, which surpasses human understanding, acts like a guarding shield around your mind and emotions.

God deeply cares for you (1 Peter 5:7) and promises to sustain you throughout life's storms (Psalm 55:22). This assurance is vital when work feels chaotic or when your thoughts spiral into fear. Practice turning to God repeatedly during your workday, even in small moments. Offer mental 'mini-prayers' to invite His calm amidst pressure.

Allow God's peace to replace anxiety one prayer at a time.

Please fill me with Your peace that goes beyond human understanding. Guard my mind against fear and guide me to rest securely in Your presence, even amidst workplace challenges. Help me to pray continuously and give thanks in all things. *Amen.* \(\mathbb{Y} \)

















Your Verse

Nehemiah 8:10 - "...Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 16:11 "You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand."
- Romans 15:13 "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him."







Devotional: God's Joy Fuels Our Strength and Motivation

Depression can rob us of joy, especially in areas like career where motivation often wanes. Nehemiah 8:10 provides a powerful reminder that joy is not merely a fleeting feeling but a divine strength given by God.

This joy is rooted in God's presence, not circumstances. When work feels draining or meaningless, turning to God can refresh your spirit and renew your passion. Psalm 16:11 assures us that God's presence fills us with deep, lasting joy and guides us on life's path.

Similarly, Romans 15:13 prayerfully encourages us to trust God as the source of hope, joy, and peace — vital ingredients for motivation and perseverance on difficult days.

Invite God daily to fill your heart with His joy. Practice gratitude, even for small blessings at work, and watch how this divine joy becomes your fuel to continue despite depression's weight.

Lord, fill my heart with Your joy today. Let Your presence be my strength when motivation fades and depression presses in. Help me to trust in You fully and find peace amid my struggles. Renew my hope and passion for the work You have given me to do. May Your joy become my sustaining force each day. *Amen.*

Your Verse

Matthew 11:28 - "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."

Supporting Scriptures

- Hebrews 4:9–10 "There remains, then, a Sabbath–rest for the people of God; for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from their works, just as God did from his."







Day 5: W Finding Rest in God

Devotional: Jesus Offers Rest for the Weary Soul

Depression combined with the pressures of work can leave you spiritually and physically exhausted. Jesus offers an open invitation in Matthew 11:28 to come to Him for rest — rest that refreshes your weary soul.

Psalm 23 paints a beautiful picture of God as our shepherd, guiding us to peaceful places to renew our strength and heal our spirit. This rest is not just physical sleep but a profound soul rest, free from the burden of striving.

Hebrews reminds us that God's rest is ongoing, a Sabbath that renews us beyond our labor. Accepting this rest means stepping back from the relentless pace and stress and trusting God fully in your personal and professional life.

Today, take time to intentionally rest in God's presence—through prayer, meditation on scripture, or quiet reflection. Allow Him to restore your heart and mind as you face the challenges ahead.

- Isaiah 40:31 "But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary."







Devotional: God's Perfect Timing in Life's Seasons

Feeling stuck or unproductive at work during depression can be discouraging. Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us there are natural seasons and timing to everything in life. Your current season—no matter how difficult—is purposeful in God's plan.

Waiting on God requires strength and courage. Psalm 27:14 encourages us to be strong and heartened while we wait, trusting He is working even when we cannot see it. This time may be one of healing or preparation.

Isaiah 40:31 offers hope that those who place their hope in the Lord will have renewed strength to rise, run, and soar again. Trust that God's timing is perfect, and He is equipping you for what lies ahead.

Rest in the assurance that your present challenges serve a greater purpose and lean into hope as you navigate your career and healing journey.
