Devotional: Obedience in Unseen Strategies

God's instructions to Joshua to conquer Jericho were not based on typical military tactics. Rather than a direct assault, He commanded a unique, patient, and faith-filled strategy: to march quietly around the city once a day for six days, then seven times on the seventh day, accompanied by priests blowing trumpets.

This plan tested Joshua's faith and obedience. It seemed unconventional, foolish even, by human standards. Yet trusting God's method meant trusting God's wisdom and power.

Similarly, God's plans in our lives are sometimes unexpected or uncomfortable. When God calls us to follow His instructions, even when they do not make sense, it is faith that obeys. Are you willing to trust His plans today, trusting that His ways are higher than ours?
