Day 5: 🚇 Boldness in Unspoken Witness

Devotional: Shining Christ's Light Quietly and Boldly

Representing Christ in a secular work environment often means *letting your light shine* through your actions more than arguments or spoken testimony alone. Matthew 5:16 urges us to demonstrate our faith by good deeds that point others to God.

Sometimes you will have chances to explain your hope verbally (1 Peter 3:15), but often your consistency, kindness, and fairness silently testify about your faith. Philippians 2:15 encourages living blamelessly so that light shines clearly amid a dark world.

Boldness at work includes integrity, humility, and a spirit of service. When colleagues see your character, curiosity about your source of strength may arise naturally. Pray today for courage to live authentically and for discerning opportunities to share your story when the moment is right.
