Day 1: 7 Trusting God's Provision

#### Your Verse

Matthew 6:31-33 - "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."

#### Supporting Scriptures

- Philippians 4:19 "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus."
- Psalm 34:10 "The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing."







Day 1: 7 Trusting God's Provision

#### Devotional: Trust God Before Financial Worries Arise

**Financial faith begins with trust.** In Matthew 6:31–33, Jesus reminds us that God's understanding of our needs is intimate and comprehensive. Unlike the anxiety of the world's scarcity mindset, God invites us to prioritize His kingdom and righteousness first. When we do this, provision follows.

God is aware of every detail in your life and is not caught off guard by your financial concerns. Seeking God first means aligning your heart and values with His reign—placing eternal priorities above material worries.

Knowing God provides all our needs frees us from the burden of fear and frantic striving. Holding onto this truth helps us live with peace, knowing our finances are under the care of a loving Father. # Devotional: Overcoming Fear by Embracing God's Abundance

**The scarcity mindset whispers that there's never enough.** It feeds fear, hoarding, and anxiety around money. But Scripture paints a radically different picture — one of abundance through God's grace.

2 Corinthians 9:8 declares that God blesses us so richly that we have more than enough to accomplish good works. This abundant provision is not just for personal comfort but for generosity and blessing others.

Rejecting scarcity begins with choosing faith over fear. It's a posture of the heart that says, "God is my source, and His resources are limitless." - Philippians 4:13 "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."
- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."







#### Devotional: God's Strength Sustains You in Hard Times

**Financial difficulties can shake our confidence and faith.** Fear and discouragement are common responses when money is tight or uncertain. But God speaks a powerful word of strength and assurance in Isaiah 41:10.

When you face financial challenges, God promises His presence, help, and strength. You are not alone in your struggles; His righteous hand upholds you through every trial.

Faith allows us to stand firm even when circumstances seem overwhelming. Philippians 4:13 reminds us that our strength comes through Christ. Likewise, Psalm 46 confirms God as our refuge—a safe place where we can find peace and courage amid storms.

#### Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."
- Matthew 7:11 "If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!"







#### Devotional: Trusting God's Peace Through Prayer

#### Prayer is our lifeline to God, especially when financial worries arise.

Philippians 4:6-7 encourages us not to be anxious but to bring every concern to God with thanksgiving. Prayer invites His peace to guard our hearts and minds.

God not only listens but responds generously when we ask. James 1:5 assures us that God gives wisdom freely to help us make sound decisions. And Jesus reveals that our Father is eager to give good gifts to those who ask (Matthew 7:11).

Faith moves us to prayer, trusting God's goodness and provision. Rather than succumbing to worry, we can bring our financial needs directly to God, knowing He delights to provide.

Take time today to bring your financial concerns before God in prayer. Thank Him for His past faithfulness and ask for wisdom and provision in this season. Receive His peace that passes understanding as you entrust your finances to Him.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- 2 Corinthians 9:7 "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."
- Luke 6:38 "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."







# Devotional: Generosity Demonstrates Trust in God's Economy

Living by faith includes stepping into generosity, especially with finances. Acts 20:35 reminds us of the blessing that comes through giving. Far from being a drain, generosity is a declaration of trust that God will provide even as we share.

God desires cheerful givers who give willingly and joyfully (2 Corinthians 9:7). Giving is not just charity—it's a spiritual act that activates God's supernatural provision (Luke 6:38).

When we release our grip on money and give generously, we demonstrate faith in God's abundant economy over scarcity. This act can break strongholds of fear and draw us deeper into His provision and peace.

Today, consider how your giving reflects your faith. Ask God to guide how you can bless others with what He's given you, and watch as your trust in Him grows.

- Romans 15:13 "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him..."







# Devotional: Embracing the Peace Beyond Financial Fear

**God's peace is distinct from the world's fleeting peace.** Jesus offers His perfect peace that calms fear, anxiety, and restlessness—especially regarding finances.

In John 14:27, Jesus commands us not to let our hearts be troubled or afraid. When financial worries mount, His peace can anchor us securely beyond circumstances.

Choosing to let Christ's peace rule in our hearts transforms how we perceive and respond to financial challenges (Colossians 3:15). Peace flows from trusting God's hope and sovereignty over our lives (Romans 15:13).

Today, invite Christ's peace to reign in your financial thoughts and decisions. Let go of fear and embrace the calm assurance that He is your ultimate provider and protector.
