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Introduction

Each day we'll dive into Scripture and reflections that relate directly to your life. You'll find hope for making decisions with courage, even when the future seems unknown or scary. Remember, God calls you to trust Him deeply and walk confidently, because He is with you always.

Get ready to explore what faith looks like in your daily life and discover how God can turn your steps into a great adventure filled with purpose.

















Day 1: 7 Trusting God When It's Uncertain

Your Verse

Genesis 12:1-4 NIV - "The Lord had said to Abram, 'Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you."

Supporting Scriptures

- Proverbs 3:5 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;"
- Psalm 56:3 "When I am afraid, I put my trust in you."







Day 1: Trusting God When It's Uncertain

Devotional: The Courage to Trust God First

Trusting God is the first step in every journey of faith. When God told Abraham (then Abram) to leave everything familiar and go to a new place, Abraham didn't know where he was going. That's real trust—stepping out without a map, relying fully on God to guide him.

As a teen, uncertainty about the future can feel overwhelming. You might be facing big decisions like what subjects to choose, where to go to college, or even how to handle relationships. Like Abraham, you don't have to have it all figured out. The important thing is to trust God with your heart and your plans.

God knows your fears and your hopes. He calls you to rest your anxiety in Him and follow where He leads, one step at a time. When you feel unsure, choose faith over fear. It's okay to be scared but don't let that stop you from moving forward. God promises to be your guide and protector every moment of the way.

Today, pray and ask God to help you trust Him fully, even when the future feels uncertain. Remember that trusting God means believing He is both powerful and loving — a perfect guide for your life.

- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."







Devotional: Stepping Boldly in Faith Every Day

Faith is more than just believing; it moves us into action. Abraham's faith was remarkable because it wasn't passive. When God called him to a new land, Abraham responded not with hesitation but with obedience.

As a teen, you can face moments where living out your faith requires courage — whether it's standing up for what's right, choosing kindness in difficult situations, or making decisions that honor God even when peers might not understand.

Taking faithful steps means trusting that God goes with you into every challenge. You don't have to have all the answers before you act. Sometimes, faith requires stepping forward even when the outcome seems uncertain, confident that God is already there before you.

Consider the ways God might be calling you to take bold, faith-filled action today. It could be reaching out to someone who needs a friend, saying no to something harmful, or simply praying for guidance. Each small courageous step builds your faith and reveals God's power working through you.

1.	What is one way God might be asking you to act in faith right now?
	How does knowing God is with you change your attitude toward risky or difficult decisions?
	What fears or doubts hold you back from living out your faith more boldly?

1.	Write about a time you acted in faith and what the experience taught you.
2.	List three practical steps you can take this week to live out your faith.
	Reflect on a Bible verse that encourages you when you face challenges in faith.







Prayer for Today

Lord, thank You for calling me to live a faith that moves me into action. Help me to be brave when I face situations that require courage, especially when I feel unsure or afraid. Remind me that I am never alone because You are always by my side. Give me strength to step forward boldly, knowing that Your plans are perfect and Your love never fails.

Your Verse

Genesis 15:5-6 NIV - "He took him outside and said, 'Look up at the heavens and count the stars... So shall your offspring be.' Abram believed the Lord, and he credited it to him as righteousness."

- Romans 4:20–21 "He did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God."
- 2 Corinthians 5:7 "For we live by faith, not by sight."







Day 3: Normal Holding God's Promises Through Change

Devotional: Clinging to God's Promises in Change

God's promises are a foundation for faith, especially during times of change.

Abraham clung to God's promise that he would have descendants as numerous as the stars—even when it seemed impossible. He chose to believe God's word over his own doubts or circumstances.

For a teen like you, change might feel unpredictable or even frightening. Yet holding tightly to God's promises gives you hope and anchorage. No matter what happens, God promises to never leave you or forsake you. His plans for you are filled with hope.

Faith means trusting God's promises even when you can't see how they will come true right now. Holding onto these promises empowers you to face changes with confidence and peace, knowing that God is at work behind the scenes.

Spend time today reflecting on the promises God has made in Scripture. Let those truths inspire you to hold strong in faith through every season of your life.
