Devotional: Strength Through Waiting on God

Devotional: Clinging to Hope in God's Good Plans

Devotional: Faithfully Waiting on God's Timing

Waiting requires trust in God's timing, not our own. Ecclesiastes teaches that every phase of life has a designated season under God's sovereign plan. While it is natural to desire immediate answers, trusting God means surrendering control and resting in His schedule.

God's timing for your adoption journey is perfect—even when it feels long or unclear. When you feel weak or discouraged, remember His grace is sufficient, and His power is displayed in those moments. Trusting God includes embracing uncertainty with faith that He is working behind the scenes.

Devotional: Choosing Joy Amid Trials and Waiting
