## Devotional: Starting With Trust Despite Uncertainty

**Paul's journey begins amid uncertain conditions as the ship sets sail, much like the times we start new chapters in life without knowing what lies ahead. In Acts 27:13-25, we see the crew responding to a south wind and setting sail, yet storms loom ahead. This passage teaches us that life's voyages are unpredictable, but God's sovereignty remains absolute.**

## Devotional: God Is With You in Every Storm

**The violent storm that hit Paul's ship reminds us of the crises we face that shake our very core.** In Acts 27:27-38, the crew endures a terrifying storm, despairing of survival. Have you felt such hopelessness when crisis struck? It's natural to fear when circumstances overwhelm us.

Yet Psalm 46:1-3 reassures us that God is our refuge and strength—present in every trouble. His presence doesn't always calm the storm immediately, but it calms our hearts amid the chaos.

*Jesus warns us that trouble will come, but He has overcome the world (John 16:33). This means our hope is anchored not in the absence of storms, but in the One who is powerful over every wave. As you reflect today, remember that God's presence is constant, even when hope feels lost.*
