Day 1: X Trusting God's Sovereignty

Your Verse

Isaiah 41:10 NIV – "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 56:3 "When I am afraid, I put my trust in you."
- Joshua 1:9 "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid... for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."







Day 1: Karating God's Sovereignty

Devotional: Embracing God's Presence to Overcome Fear

Fear can feel very real when you face an unknown future or difficult challenges. But God's Word reminds us that we don't face those fears alone. **Isaiah 41:10** assures us that God is with us—always present, always powerful. When we remember God's sovereignty, our perspective shifts from fear to confidence.

Faith simply means trusting God's control over circumstances. It means believing that He is bigger than the fears that try to overwhelm us. Take a moment to reflect on times when God has been faithful in your life. These are His fingerprints reassuring you that He will continue working all things for good.

As you walk into this day, declare with courage that God is your strength and shield. When anxiety knocks, speak the promises of Scripture to yourself. Let faith silence doubt and fear.

Day 2: Neplacing Anxiety with Faith

Your Verse

Philippians 4:6-7 NIV - "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God."

Supporting Scriptures

- Matthew 6:34 "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself."
- 1 Peter 5:7 "Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you."







Day 2: Neplacing Anxiety with Faith

Devotional: Praying Away Anxiety Through Thanksgiving

Anxiety often tries to steal our peace by convincing us that our problems are too big or that God might not be able to help. But **Philippians 4:6–7** teaches us a beautiful practice: whenever worry creeps in, bring it to God in prayer with a thankful heart. This act of faith shifts our focus from problems to God's provision and care.

Trusting God includes casting your cares on Him because He cares deeply for you. Giving your fears to God is a spiritual exchange: your worry for His peace. His peace guards our hearts and minds like a shield that calms the storm inside us.

Today, reflect on the power of prayer and thanksgiving to move you beyond fear. Consider starting a simple daily habit of giving your fears and wishes to God—letting His peace fill the space where anxiety used to be.

Reflect and Apply

1.	What worries do you tend to carry daily?
2.	How can prayer help you actively replace anxiety with faith?
3.	Do you find it easy or hard to be thankful in anxious moments? Why?
4.	What difference might it make to approach God with thanksgiving even before receiving answers?

Journaling Prompts

1.	Write a prayer presenting your biggest concerns to God with thanksgiving.
2.	List blessings you are grateful for that remind you of God's goodness.
3.	Reflect on a time when prayer brought you peace amid worry.

- Romans 8:38–39 "Nothing can separate us from the love of God..."







Devotional: Courage Empowered by God's Spirit Within

Choosing faith over fear calls for courage — not the absence of fear, but the resolve to move forward because of God's Spirit within you. **2 Timothy 1:7** reminds us that God empowers us with a spirit of power, love, and self-discipline, not fear.

Faith strengthens us to face unknown futures, take risks for what we believe God is calling us to, and stay rooted in God's love that can never be taken from us. You don't need to be fearless; you need to be faithful.

As you prepare to step into what comes next, remember you are equipped by God's Spirit. Let faith fuel your courage. Hold on to the hope that God surrounds you with His unstoppable love, giving you all you need to thrive.

3.	What does it mean to have assurance in the unseen promises of God?
4.	How does God's love help you face uncertainty?

2.	Reflect on what power, love, and self-discipline look like in your life.
3.	List ways you can remind yourself daily of God's unshakeable love.
