Devotional: Faith Beyond the Limits of Time

News came that Jairus's daughter had died, seemingly ending all hope. Yet Jesus responded with words that defy worldly logic: "Don't be afraid; just believe." His response challenges us to trust in God's timing even when it seems too late.

Often, we face delays or hear discouraging news that make us doubt God's power and presence. Jairus's story reminds us that God's timing is perfect and beyond human comprehension. What seems like an endpoint to us is often the beginning of God's miraculous work.

Devotional: When Faith Calls, Jesus Responds

The woman with the bleeding condition exemplifies faith that elicits Jesus's response. Despite years of suffering and many disappointments, she reached out in faith, believing Jesus could heal her.

This teaches us that faith—even when minimal—can move Jesus's heart. Our faith sings louder than our fears. Jairus's faith and the woman's faith intersect in the story, highlighting that Jesus honors sincere belief regardless of how long we have waited or suffered.

Our faith is precious to God. It's the channel through which His power flows. Whether we come with certainty or trembling hope, Jesus listens and responds to every step toward Him.

Jesus's presence is a comfort to the brokenhearted. Jairus came in faith, and Jesus met his family's need with power and compassion, reminding us that no situation is hidden from His loving gaze.
