### Devotional: God Hears Your Heart's Deepest Hurts


### Prayer for Today

### Devotional: God's Peace Guards Your Heart and Mind

Hearing loss or deafness can bring anxiety and fear, but God offers a peace unlike anything the world can give. Paul advises us specifically to replace worry with prayer and thanksgiving, presenting every concern to God. This daily habit invites God's supernatural peace to guard our hearts and minds, acting like a shield against fear and confusion.

Jesus' promise echoes this reality—His peace is a gift freely given and unlike any temporary calmness we might seek elsewhere. Holding onto this peace requires focused trust and a heart that continually returns to God's love even when circumstances seem overwhelming.

As you face your health challenges today, try to intentionally exchange thoughts of anxiety for prayer. Express your gratitude for God's faithfulness, no matter how small it feels. Let His peace fill the silent moments where worry once lived.

### Your Verse

Mark 7:32-35 NIV - "There some people brought to Jesus a man who was deaf and could hardly talk, and they begged Jesus to place his hand on him. After Jesus took him aside, he put his fingers into the man's ears. Then he spit and touched the man's tongue. He looked up to heaven and with a deep sigh said to him, 'Ephphatha!' (which means 'Be opened!'). At this, the man's ears were opened, his tongue was loosened and he began to speak plainly."

### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Matthew 9:29 "According to your faith let it be done to you."
- Hebrews 11:1 "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."







### Devotional: Invite God to Open What Feels Closed

Jesus' healing of the man who was deaf reminds us that faith plays an essential role in restoration. This powerful story shows us that faith is active — the people brought the man to Jesus and pleaded for healing. Jesus' command, 'Ephphatha,' illustrates the authority of God's Word to open and restore what is broken.

Faith is not passive waiting but an inviting of God's miraculous power into our lives. As believers facing hearing loss, we are called to express trust in God's ability to work—even when healing may seem unlikely or slow. God honors faith and welcomes us to boldly approach Him with confidence.

Reflect on how your faith can be a channel for God's healing touch today. Bring your hearing loss honestly before Him and ask for that divine opening, trusting that God is above all our limitations.

Today, take intentional time to ask God for wisdom in your health journey. Seek His guidance on how to care for your hearing, your emotional well-being, and your relationships. Trust that He delights in leading you on the right path, even when the way seems uncertain.
