Day 1: • Strengthening Commitment to Missions

Devotional: Run the Race in Faithful Discipline

Paul compares the Christian life to a race—one that requires intentional effort, endurance, and discipline. Supporting missions similarly calls us to maintain steady commitment, even when immediate results aren't visible. Like an athlete training for a prize, we develop spiritual discipline through regular prayer for missionaries, thoughtful giving, and persistent encouragement. Such discipline reflects reliance on the Spirit, who equips us with power, love, and self-control (2 Timothy 1:7).

Without discipline, enthusiasm can falter and mission support becomes inconsistent. Yet God's Word assures us that while discipline may feel challenging initially, it ultimately yields righteousness and peace (Hebrews 12:11). By choosing to 'run in such a way as to get the prize,' we align ourselves with God's eternal purposes in missions.

Ask yourself: How can you cultivate spiritual discipline today to strengthen your ongoing commitment to missions? What small steps can you take this week to 'train' in faithfulness?

Devotional: The Joy and Discipline of Generous Giving

Supporting missions requires more than occasional giving; it demands disciplined generosity—a deliberate choice made regularly and cheerfully. Paul reminds us that God loves a cheerful giver who gives not out of obligation but from a willing heart. This is a discipline of the heart as much as the wallet.

God invites us to honor Him with our resources and promises abundant blessings when we faithfully give. The discipline of tithing or intentional mission giving trains us to trust God's provision and prioritize His kingdom. When we cultivate this habit, giving becomes a joyful spiritual act, reflecting our faith and obedience.

Consider: Are your giving habits reflective of disciplined faithfulness? What prevents or encourages you to give consistently to mission causes? Discipline in giving aligns our priorities with God and fuels the extraordinary work of world missions.
