#### Devotional: Start With a God-Given Fire

**Faith begins as a spark.** The psalmist declares that God's Word lights our steps, providing direction in a world full of darkness. Men often start their spiritual journey passionate and committed, but keeping that flame alive requires intentionality. Paul urges Timothy to "fan into flame" the gift God gave him — a call for continuous nurturing of our spiritual gifts.

Today marks the beginning of a journey to protect and cultivate that spark into a steady, guiding flame throughout your lifespan. Start with God's Word as your light and fuel for your faith.

#### Devotional: Strength for the Storms of Life

**Devotion to God bookends our day.** Psalm 143 expresses a yearning to begin each day wrapped in God's unfailing love. The early morning was Jesus' chosen time for prayer and communion with the Father, setting a pattern for faithful men to follow.

Each morning brings new mercy and opportunity to trust God anew, while evenings offer a moment to reflect on His faithfulness throughout the day. These daily spiritual rhythms guard the heart and nurture consistent devotion that lasts a lifetime.

Faithful living thrives when grounded in daily encounters with God. Let prayer and reflection be your anchors from sunrise to sunset, renewing your commitment and passion continually.

The greatest testimony of a faithful man is finishing well. Revelation encourages believers to remain faithful even in the face of death, promising the crown of life to those who persevere. Paul's final words to Timothy celebrate the completion of a lifelong race marked by devout faith.

Fixing our eyes on Jesus anchors this lifelong journey and motivates us to keep running, no matter the obstacles we face. Maintaining youthful zeal in later years requires commitment, prayer, and dependence on the Lord.

Your devotion is not just for the sunrise but for the entire day. Embrace the encouragement to remain faithful until your sunset, knowing God honors every step of your journey.
