#### Introduction

#### Devotional: Trusting God to Provide Daily Needs

When raising children alone, uncertainty about daily provisions can weigh heavily on your heart. Bills, food, school supplies, and emotional needs often feel endless. Yet the Bible assures us that God is not indifferent to our needs. Paul's encouragement to the Philippians reminds us that God's provision is not limited but abundant, coming from the riches of His glory.

Allow yourself to release the burden of anxiety to God. The same God who cared for the Israelites in the wilderness knows your needs intimately—physical, emotional, and spiritual. By trusting Him daily, you model faith and resilience to your children.

Faith is often cultivated in dependance on God when circumstances feel unstable. Let today's promise comfort you, and remember that God delights in meeting your needs exactly when you need them.

#### Devotional: Finding Strength in God Amidst Fatigue

The demands of single parenting can leave you feeling drained, exhausted, and sometimes completely depleted. The weight of meeting every need and making every decision may seem unbearable. Yet Scripture reminds us that our strength doesn't come from ourselves—it comes from the One who never grows tired.

**Isaiah's words are a balm for wearied hearts: God provides strength exactly when we have none.** In moments when you feel weak or incapable, God's power rises within you. His grace wraps around your weakness, transforming it into endurance, patience, and renewed hope.

Don't hesitate to lean fully on God's strength today. He understands your struggles intimately and delights to empower the weary through His Spirit. This strength is not just for survival—it is for thriving in your calling as a loving parent.

### Devotional: Demonstrating God's Love as a Single Parent

One of the greatest gifts you can give your children is the experience of unconditional love. As a single parent, the pressure to meet everyone's needs can sometimes overshadow the heart of parenting: **reflecting God's perfect love**. Remember, your ability to love your children deeply comes from God's love for you.

John's declaration reminds us that our love flows because God loved us first. When you face challenges in parenting, let God's love refill your well so you can pour out patience, grace, and compassion. Your children don't just need a provider—they need a parent who loves with the steadfast, forgiving heart of Christ.

Walk in God's love daily, and take time to nurture your own relationship with Him, so your family feels safe, valued, and deeply loved.

#### Devotional: Seeking God's Guidance in Parenting

Parenting requires countless decisions—big and small—that affect your children's present and future. As a single parent, the weight of responsibility can feel overwhelming. The good news is God's Word promises that He delights in giving wisdom generously to those who ask.

James encourages us to bring every question and uncertainty to God. When you seek Him first, trusting His guidance, you free yourself from the pressure to have all the answers. His wisdom leads to paths of peace and provision.

Practice surrendering tough decisions to God through prayer and reflection today. Invite Him to illuminate the best choices and give you confidence to act with clarity and love.

#### Devotional: Drawing Strength from God's Joy

Parenting solo is often filled with moments of exhaustion and trial. It's easy to get caught up in the difficulties and forget about joy. Yet Scripture reminds us that **the joy of the Lord is a supernatural strength** that equips us to keep going.

Nehemiah's words encourage us to find joy in God amidst hardship, not despite it. This joy is not dependent on circumstances but springs from a deep relationship with God who redeems and restores.

Choose today to invite God's joy into your heart. Celebrate small victories, cling to hope, and allow joy to fuel your resilience as a parent. Your children will see and learn how joy can shine even in tough seasons.

#### Your Verse

John 14:27 - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Philippians 4:6-7 "Do not be anxious about anything... And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds."
- Isaiah 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."







#### Devotional: Embracing God's Peace Over Fear

Anxiety over finances, safety, and future can feel overwhelming when raising kids alone. Jesus promises a peace unlike any the world offers—a calm assurance rooted in His presence.

This peace is a divine gift, accessible to all who trust Him. It doesn't mean problems disappear, but that your heart can rest despite them. When you feel anxiety creeping in, take a moment to breathe deeply and remember God's promise to guard your heart and mind.

Let today be a practice of surrendering fears to God and receiving His perfect peace. This peace strengthens you to face each challenge with confidence and courage for your family's sake.

#### Devotional: Embedding God's Truth in Family Life

Raising children is not only about meeting physical needs but also about nurturing their souls. God instructs parents to teach His Word consistently—to live faith out loud in daily life.

Single parents face time constraints and pressures, but intentional moments with God's Word can transform a home. These moments create a spiritual foundation that carries your children through life's storms.

Seek simple, practical ways to weave Scripture into your routines. It might be a nightly Bible story, a morning prayer, or discussing a verse over a meal. The goal is to make God's presence palpable and reliable in your home.

#### Devotional: Trusting God's Shield Around the Family

Safety is a paramount concern for parents, especially when facing the challenges of raising children alone. Psalm 91 comforts us with the assurance that God places angels to guard us and surrounds us with protection.

While we take practical steps to keep our family safe, it is God's supernatural protection that gives the deepest peace. Sometimes threats come from the outside world, other times from within—fear, temptation, or discouragement. God's shield extends to every area.

Commit to entrusting the safety of your children to God daily. Pray, asking Him to cover their paths and keep their hearts secure as you guide them through life's uncertainties.

# Devotional: Cultivating Compassionate Communication

Communication is key in parenting, especially in single-parent homes where emotional bonds are vital. James and Proverbs teach that good listening precedes wise speaking, fostering understanding and empathy.

**Listening to your children with compassion creates safe spaces for their hearts.** It encourages openness and builds trust. Likewise, choosing words that build up rather than tear down nurtures their identity and confidence.

Practice listening deeply today. Pause before responding and offer words that strengthen and encourage. This will bless your relationship and honor God's call to love.
