Your Verse

John 13:34–35 NIV "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 John 4:7 "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God."
- Romans 13:10 "Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law."







Devotional: Love: The Mark of Your Faith

Love is the foundational mark of a believer living their faith openly. Jesus gave us a revolutionary command: to love one another as He loved us. This love is not just an emotion but concrete action characterized by kindness, patience, and selflessness. When we genuinely love others, our faith shines through naturally, and people recognize Christ's presence in us.

- Matthew 5:37 "All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one."







Day 2: 🍑 Building Trust with Integrity

Devotional: Faithfulness Builds Real Trust

Trust is the currency of genuine relationships. When living your faith in front of others, integrity matters deeply. - James 1:19 "Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry."







Devotional: Speak Words That Build and Bless

Our words hold incredible power in relationships. When living your faith visibly, how you speak can either build up or tear down. Paul encourages believers to let all conversations be full of grace—kind, thoughtful, and tactful, like salt adding flavor and preservation.

Grace-filled speech means intentionally choosing words that uplift, encourage, and provide wise answers, even in difficult situations. It means listening well and controlling anger before it erupts. Your conversations can reflect the heart of Christ and open hearts to Him.

Today, ask God to guard your tongue and help you speak with kindness and wisdom. Let your conversations soften hearts and create opportunities for God to work in others' lives through your faithful witness.

Your Verse

Ephesians 4:32 NIV "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

- Colossians 3:13 "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone."







Day 4: W Forgiveness Frees Relationships

Devotional: The Power and Peace of Forgiveness

Forgiveness is essential to healthy, faith-filled relationships. Carrying grudges or bitterness blocks the flow of God's grace and hinders your witness to others. Paul calls believers to forgive just as God has forgiven us in Christ—a deep, costly, and complete forgiveness.

When you forgive, you release yourself and the other person from the prison of past offenses. This freedom allows love to grow and restores peace. Forgiveness is not always easy—it may require humility and prayer—but it reflects the heart of God to a watching world.

Consider any relationships where forgiveness is needed. Ask God to soften your heart and empower you to forgive fully. Remember, forgiveness opens the door to restoration and deeper faith walking in front of others.

Prayer for Today

Devotional: Choosing Peace Amidst Conflict

Conflict is a natural part of relationships, but how we respond reveals the depth of our faith. Scripture directs believers to pursue peace as far as it depends on them, showing humility and willingness to reconcile. Avoiding or escalating conflict damages faith witness and relationships.

Facing conflict with wisdom requires prayer, courage, and a heart that desires restoration over winning. Jesus taught us to approach one another gently and privately when offenses occur. This approach models Christ's love and grace, opening the path to reconciliation.

Today, reflect on any current conflicts. Ask God for wisdom and strength to seek peace, and commit to being an agent of reconciliation, living your faith visibly through your pursuit of unity.

3.	Make a plan to initiate peace-building conversations this week.







Prayer for Today

God of peace, teach me to walk in humility and courage when conflicts arise. Help me seek Your wisdom and act with love and grace. Day 6: 6 Boldness to Share Your Faith


Prayer for Today
