# Devotional: Trusting God as the Source of All Provision

- Deuteronomy 26:2 "Take some of the firstfruits of all that you produce from the soil of the land the Lord your God is giving you and put them in a basket."







# Devotional: Prioritizing God with Your Income's Firstfruits

Honoring God with the first of your income symbolizes trust and gratitude. Giving Him the firstfruits means prioritizing God above personal needs or desires, recognizing He blesses all your efforts.

This practice isn't about legalism but cultivating a spirit of thankfulness and prioritization. When applied to a modern salary or business, it means consistently giving your tithe before spending on anything else.

By entrusting God with the first portion, you declare that He is more important than money itself. This aligns your heart with His and invites blessings into your life and career. Consider ways you can honor God with your firstfruits faithfully.

#### Your Verse

Matthew 6:31-33 - "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."

#### Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."
- Psalm 34:10 "The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing."







Day 6: Vercoming Financial Fear

#### Devotional: Faith Over Fear in Financial Giving

Fear can paralyze faithful giving, but God calls us to trust Him fully. Matthew 6:31–33 encourages believers to seek God's kingdom first, assuring that necessary provisions will follow. When fear of not having enough tempts you to withhold tithes, remember God's promises.

God's presence drives out fear (Isaiah 41:10). Trust in Him means releasing control and embracing His faithfulness even in uncertain financial seasons. In your business or salary, tithing is a step of courage and surrender that reflects reliance on God instead of self.
