### Devotional: Small Trusts Build Big Faith

**Faithfulness starts with small acts of trust.** Luke 16:10 reminds us that when we're entrusted with little things and we handle them well, God and others know they can trust us with more. This is powerful for children to understand because every small task — like helping at home, following rules, or being honest — builds character.

Trust isn't only about big responsibilities; it begins when we consistently show care and obedience in everyday moments. Think about how Jesus trusted children and praised their simple faith. God uses these moments to grow our hearts, teaching us patience and integrity.

- John 13:34 "Love one another as I have loved you."







### Devotional: Showing God's Love in Small Ways

**Faithfulness is shown not only in how we complete tasks but in how we love others.** 1 Corinthians 13 describes love as patient and kind, qualities that children can practice every day. When you show love through small acts—like sharing toys or speaking kindly—you demonstrate faithfulness to God's command.

Jesus calls us to love others just as He loves us. Loving faithfully in little ways can brighten someone's day and show God's love through our actions. Even small efforts have big impacts.

Today, look for ways to show loving kindness in your family, school, and friendships. Remember, faithfulness is love in action!

### Devotional: Growing in Patience While We Wait

**Faithfulness often requires patience, especially when waiting for something important.** Waiting can be hard for children, whether it's waiting for a turn, a birthday, or an answer to prayer. Psalm 27:14 encourages us to be strong and hopeful as we wait.

Faithfulness means trusting God's timing even when we don't understand. When we learn to wait patiently, we develop maturity and strengthen our relationship with God. Patience lets us show love and respect to others around us.

### Devotional: Trustworthy Hearts Please God

God delights in honesty and being trustworthy. Proverbs 12:22 reminds us how important it is to tell the truth and be reliable, even in small matters. Children often face choices to be truthful or to hide mistakes. Choosing honesty builds integrity and reflects God's character.

Faithfulness means living consistently with God's truth. When we admit mistakes and act honestly, we grow closer to God and earn the trust of those around us. Remember, no act of honesty is too small or unimportant in God's eyes.

Today, be brave to speak truthfully and practice integrity in everything you do.

### Devotional: Joyful Hearts Serve God

Faithfulness includes serving others joyfully and wholeheartedly. Colossians 3:23 encourages us to work as though we are serving the Lord, not just people. When children help at home or with friends, their service becomes a worshipful act.

Jesus showed us the greatest example of serving others lovingly and humbly. Even in little ways, serving with a good attitude honors God and blesses those around us.

Today, find joy in serving whether it's helping a family member, friend, or teacher. Remember, God is pleased with a willing heart.

### Devotional: Faithful Obedience Brings Blessings

#### Obedience to God brings blessings and opens doors to His plans.

Deuteronomy 28:1 promises blessings for those who fully obey God. Children may find obedience challenging, but it's a key way to show love and faithfulness to God.

Jesus reminds us that love is shown through obedience. Sometimes obeying parents or God's Word feels tough, but it leads to peace and favor. William Carey once said, "Expect great things from God; attempt great things for God." Obedience helps us attempt the great things God has for our lives.
