Devotional: Understanding God's perfect timing

Day 3: 🛕 Seeking God's Guidance in Decisions

Devotional: Listening and depending on God's wisdom

Deciding about family size and timing can feel overwhelming, but God promises to guide us. Proverbs 3:5–6 calls us to trust God wholeheartedly and not rely solely on our understanding. When we submit every step to Him, He will make our paths straight—clear and purposeful.

Family planning decisions bear weight, and asking God for wisdom is vital. James assures us that God generously gives wisdom to all who ask. There is no shame in seeking His input often and honestly. Psalm 32 reminds us God wants to instruct and counsel us lovingly.

Prayer and openness to God's whisper help discern His direction. Sometimes His guidance comes as peace; other times as conviction or confirmation through Scripture, counsel, or circumstances. Be patient as you listen. Avoid rushing decisions and instead invite God intimately into the process.

Remember: Wisdom from above always leads to peace and alignment with God's best.
