
Fellowship Across Cultures: United in Christ

global family and be a living testimony to His reconciling love!










Day 1: C Embracing Unity in Diversity

Devotional: One in Christ: Celebrating Our Differences

Devotional: United as One: God's Heart for His People

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 John 4:7 "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God."
- Romans 12:10 "Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves."







Day 3: E Breaking Barriers Through Love

Devotional: Love: The Bond Beyond Boundaries

Love is the great unifier that breaks down walls of division and suspicion.

Paul exhorts believers in *Colossians 3:14* to crown all virtues with love — the binding agent that perfects unity. Without love, cultural differences can become barriers instead of blessings.

1 John reminds us that love originates from God and flows through us to others. Genuine fellowship is impossible without love that seeks the good of the other, especially when cultural misunderstandings arise.

Romans 12:10 calls us to honorable devotion toward one another, encouraging humility and respect which are vital in cross-cultural relationships. Today, pray for a heart to love freely and break down any prejudices lurking within.

- 1 Corinthians 12:14 "Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many."







Day 4: **B** Growing Together in Christ

Devotional: Belonging and Growing in One Body

Spiritual growth flourishes best within community, especially a diverse one.

Paul reminds the Ephesians they are no longer strangers but part of God's household — a concept that transcends cultural separation and invites us into belonging.

Just as a body needs all parts to function well, the Church thrives when every believer is valued and participates fully, as seen in *Romans 12:5* and *1 Corinthians 12:14*. Diversity within the body brings unique gifts that enrich and strengthen the whole fellowship.

Today, reflect on how your part contributes to the spiritual growth of your community. Celebrate the unique gifts others bring, and consider how you can help nurture an environment where everyone feels at home and grows together in Christ.

Hebrews reminds us not to neglect gathering together but to encourage one another, a vital rhythm in maintaining fellowship that embraces diverse cultures. As we close this study, let your heart commit to reflecting this heavenly fellowship by welcoming, encouraging, and loving your diverse brothers and sisters in Christ.
