- Hebrews 10:24–25 "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together."







#### Devotional: The Power of Togetherness in Hard Times

Unemployment can feel isolating and overwhelming. But these verses remind us that God designed us for fellowship, to uplift and support one another in every season. Ecclesiastes highlights the power in partnership—two people can help each other stay steady when life's challenges cause one to stumble. During job loss, having a community to lean on prevents loneliness and discouragement from taking root.

Galatians 6:2 calls us to actively carry one another's burdens. This means more than sympathy; it's a call to practical, compassionate action. Fellow believers can provide emotional support, encouragement, advice, and tangible help like meals or job leads. Similarly, Hebrews encourages us not to forsake meeting together even when we're struggling; the gathering of God's people fuels hope and reminds us we are not alone.

Today, reflect on your current fellowship relationships. Who encourages you? How do you support others? Openness in fellowship creates a safe space to share fears and dreams amidst unemployment's uncertainty.
