James 1:19 calls us to practice patience—listening more and speaking less—while Proverbs reminds us that gentle responses prevent anger and foster peace. When spoken in love and guided by the Spirit, our words create an environment where fellowship thrives, even amid disagreements or challenges.

In your business partnership, seek to cultivate a culture of respectful, uplifting communication. Ask God to help you listen carefully, speak truthfully but kindly, and handle conflicts with grace so your unity remains strong.
