Introduction

Welcome to this 5-day Bible study on Fellowship in Caring for Creation. Devotional: God's Design: Caring for Creation Together

Our Creator places us in the garden not just to enjoy it but to *take care* of it. Genesis 2:15 shows us that caring for creation is part of God's original design for humanity. This stewardship is an act of fellowship — a partnership with God and with others to protect the world He has made.

When we consider the earth as the Lord's possession (Psalm 24:1), our role shifts from dominion used for personal gain to sacred responsibility shared in community. Colossians reminds us that all things exist for Christ's purpose and glory. Therefore, caring for creation is a way to honor God deeply.

Today, reflect on how God's design calls us to care for the environment not as isolated individuals but as members of a fellowship that shares a divine mandate. Caring together unites us in purpose, strengthens our faith, and models God's love in tangible ways.

Devotional: Strength in Fellowship for Creation Care

- Galatians 6:9 "Let us not become weary in doing good."







Day 3: Berving Through Stewardship

Devotional: Zeal and Faithfulness in Serving God

Serving God through stewardship requires zeal and determination. Romans 12:11 calls us to keep our spiritual fervor strong as we serve the Lord in all areas, including caring for His creation.

Jesus teaches us in Matthew 25:40 that serving others is an extension of serving Him, and creation is a form of neighbor we cannot overlook. Caring for the environment is loving those who depend on it now and in the future.

Galatians encourages persistence without weariness. Fellowship sustains us when the task seems overwhelming. Together, energized by God's Spirit and love, we can serve with renewed passion and hope.

- Revelation 4:11 "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power."







Day 4: 🛞 Reflecting God's Glory Together

Devotional: Honoring God's Glory Through Stewardship

Our care for creation reflects God's glory on earth. Isaiah's vision reveals a planet filled with God's holiness. As His stewards, we participate in displaying that glory by nurturing His world.

The psalmist reminds us that creation exists by God's word and authority. Our stewardship honors His creative power by protecting what He has spoken into existence.

In Revelation, we see that giving glory and honor to God is a fitting response as we recognize His hand in all things. Fellowship provides the context for expressing this worship through collective action and praise.
