#### Devotional: Grace Heals and Restores Relationships

Broken relationships often carry deep wounds, but God's grace is the ultimate healer. Psalm 147:3 assures us that the Lord binds our wounds and restores our hearts. Fellowship is wounded when offenses create distance, but healing begins when we invite God's grace into the pain.

As we forgive and seek fellowship, we participate in God's ministry of reconciliation, as highlighted in 2 Corinthians 5:18. This sacred calling involves both receiving and offering grace that heals. Matthew 18:21–22 NIV – "Peter asked, 'Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times?' Jesus answered, 'I tell you, not seven times, but seventy–seven times.'"

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Luke 6:37 NIV "Forgive, and you will be forgiven."
- Mark 11:25 NIV "And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."







Day 3: 😢 Letting Go: Freedom Through Forgiveness

#### Devotional: Freedom Comes When We Forgive Fully

Forgiveness brings freedom when we choose to let go of grudges. In Matthew 18, Jesus teaches Peter that forgiveness should be limitless—not bound by a number or condition. This radical grace reflects the heart of God, who desires us to release pain and be free from the chains of resentment.

Forgiving does not mean forgetting or excusing wrongs, but it removes their power to control us. Luke 6:37 and Mark 11:25 remind us that forgiveness impacts not only our fellowship with others but our relationship with God Himself. Holding onto unforgiveness hinders our spiritual walk and obstructs the fullness of God's blessings.

Today, consider what you might be holding onto and ask God to help you forgive freely. Embrace the freedom that comes from releasing others and receive God's grace flowing through you into restored fellowship.

# Devotional: Practice Grace to Maintain Peace and Fellowship

Forgiveness is most powerful when put into daily practice. Romans 12:17–18 exhorts us to pursue peace actively, rejecting retaliation and striving for right relationships. Forgiveness in fellowship requires not only releasing past offenses but also maintaining peace through humility and self-control.

Anger is natural but can lead to sin if unresolved (Ephesians 4:26–27). Prompt forgiveness and reconciliation help prevent bitterness from taking root. Galatians 6 speaks to the Spirit-led restoration of those who stumble, guiding us to approach others with gentleness and grace.

- 1 John 1:7 NIV "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another..."







#### Devotional: Love and Unity: The Fruit of Forgiveness

Forgiveness leads to renewed fellowship that reflects the love of Christ. Jesus' command to love one another (John 13:34–35) ties directly to our call to forgiveness. When we forgive, we align ourselves with His love and demonstrate true discipleship.

Paul's encouragement in Philippians 2 emphasizes unity in spirit and purpose, something only possible when we practice grace and forgiveness. Walking in the light (1 John 1:7) provides clarity and holiness that cultivates fellowship free from hidden offenses.

Celebrate the restoration that forgiveness brings. As relationships are renewed, enjoy the joy and strength found in unity. Fellowship grounded in grace is a powerful testimony to the world and a source of spiritual vitality within the body of Christ.
