Devotional: The Power of Gospel Partnership

- *Romans 12:15 – "Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn."*



Day 2: 🧡 Sharing the Burden

Devotional: Carrying Burdens Together in Missions

Fellowship in global missions involves deeply sharing the joys and struggles of those we serve and work alongside. In Galatians 6:2, Paul instructs us to carry one another's burdens as a direct fulfillment of Christ's law of love. This is especially true in missions, where cultural challenges, hardship, and loneliness are common.

Paul reminds the Corinthians that God comforts us in trials so that we can extend that same comfort to others. This reciprocal support binds mission partners in empathy and strength.

Sharing burdens requires intentional vulnerability and commitment—whether that looks like financial support, emotional encouragement, or physical presence. Romans calls us to rejoice and weep together, reflecting God's heart for empathy across distance. When we share burdens, fellowship becomes a source of resilience and hope, demonstrating Christ's love tangibly to the world.

Devotional: Sharpening One Another in Missions

Proverbs 27:17 likens the sharpening of one believer by another to the refining process that builds strength and skill. Mission partnerships transcend mere logistical cooperation; they are opportunities for mutual edification and learning.

Ecclesiastes highlights the benefits of working together—providing support, encouragement, and accountability. These elements are vital in mission fields where isolation and exhaustion are ever-present risks.

When we seek God's wisdom as a community, we are better equipped to navigate cultural complexities and spiritual battles. James reassures us that God generously grants wisdom to those who ask. In communal fellowship, we experience God's guidance more clearly, as others bring insight and divine encouragement into our lives.
