#### Devotional: The Power of Gathering in Fellowship

Fellowship is foundational not only for our social lives but for our spiritual health. The writer of Hebrews encourages believers to meet regularly, spurring one another on toward love and encouragement. When studying prophecy, this is especially important. The themes of end times can feel daunting or even frightening when viewed alone, but in fellowship, we share encouragement and clarity.

Early believers in Acts exemplified deep fellowship, sharing everything in common and growing together in truth and love. Day 2: C Studying Prophecy Together

#### Devotional: How Fellowship Illuminates Prophetic Truth

Prophecy can be complex, mysterious, and sometimes intimidating. Yet Scripture calls us to value prophecy, as it points us to God's ultimate plan. When we study prophetic messages together, a **light shines brighter** — our understanding is enriched through shared perspectives and insights.

Peter urges believers to pay close attention to prophecy, treating it as trustworthy and illuminating. When we study alone, we may misinterpret or miss important details, but fellowship allows us to clarify, question, and learn humbly from one another.

The book of Revelation itself encourages public reading and communal reflection. This fosters both awe and hope, as we recognize God's sovereignty and promises. We also see in Colossians that teaching and admonishing each other brings wisdom that fuels spiritual growth. Study of prophecy is no exception.

Today, seek out or appreciate a fellowship in which prophecy is valued as a source of encouragement and preparation.

#### Devotional: Sharing Hope as a Fellowship

Fellowship is not just about study—it is about **encouragement**. The Thessalonian believers were told to comfort and strengthen each other with words about Christ's return. Prophecy offers profound hope, reminding us that difficult times will end, and God's justice will prevail.

In fellowship, sharing this hope aloud helps hearts stay steadfast. Romans reminds us that Scripture builds endurance, and Hebrews stresses the need for daily encouragement to prevent doubt or discouragement from hardening our hearts.

When we proclaim God's promises together, doubts diminish and joy increases. Fellowship becomes a vital means to hold fast to hope—even when current events seem challenging. The end times, rather than causing fear, become a catalyst for mutual upliftment.

Today, commit to encouraging others with the hope found in Scripture, especially when discussing prophecy.

# Devotional: Spiritual Armor and Fellowship Protection

Studying prophecy requires vigilance. Evil influences often seek to distort truth and stir fear. Paul encourages believers to put on the full armor of God, standing firm against deception and discouragement.

In fellowship, we have a safeguard against false teachings or misunderstanding because multiple perspectives allow us to discern truth more reliably. John's letter reminds us to 'test the spirits' — not accept every interpretation blindly.

When we study end-times prophecy together, we help one another stay vigilant, asking honest questions and seeking spiritual wisdom. This collective spiritual protection helps preserve our faith and hope.

As you engage with prophetic teachings, rely on your fellowship to provide accountability, insight, and prayerful discernment to guard your heart and mind.

- 1 Peter 1:13 "Prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given when Jesus Christ is revealed."

#### Devotional: Anchored in Hope Through Fellowship

**Hope is an anchor** for the soul as we study prophecy and anticipate Christ's return. Paul's letter to Titus reminds us that this is a blessed hope to sustain and motivate us.
