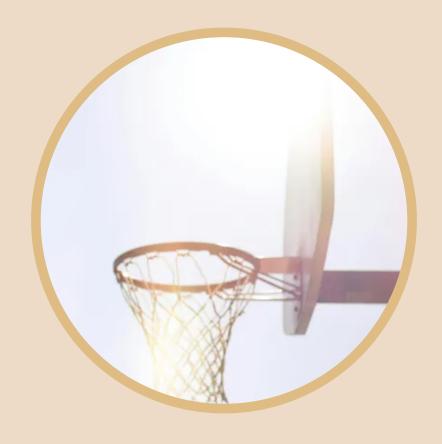
guide you towards building a fellowship that honors Him and strengthens your team in faith.

# Devotional: Serving Others: Love in Action on the Team

Love is the heartbeat of fellowship. Jesus commands us to love one another just as He has loved us. This love is active, expressed through humble service and putting others first. Within sports teams, this means going beyond just playing well—it means willingly supporting your teammates, celebrating their victories, and carrying their burdens.

Serving others can be as simple as offering encouragement after a tough practice or stepping up to help a teammate in need. These acts, though small, build a culture of love that strengthens the entire team. Paul reminds us in Philippians to value others above ourselves, a mindset that transforms relationships from competition to collaboration.

Reflect on your role in your team. How can you show Jesus' love through serving teammates? Serving doesn't weaken you; it reflects Christ's strength and humility, and makes your team a powerful witness of faith.

### Prayer for Today

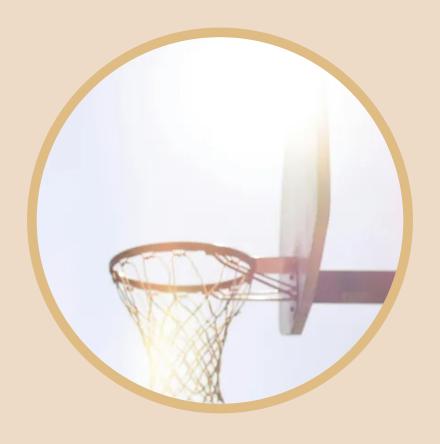

In athletic communities, teammates experience both triumphs and trials—injuries, losses, personal challenges. Bearing these burdens together creates resilience and deepens connection.

Romans reminds us to rejoice and mourn alongside others. This empathy transforms a team into a true family where no one faces hardship alone. Ecclesiastes beautifully illustrates the power of companionship—helping one another rise when fallen.

As athletes, recognizing and responding to each other's emotional and spiritual needs fuels team strength. Ask yourself: How attentive are you to the unseen burdens your teammates carry? Your willingness to listen, encourage, and support can change a life and a team's destiny.

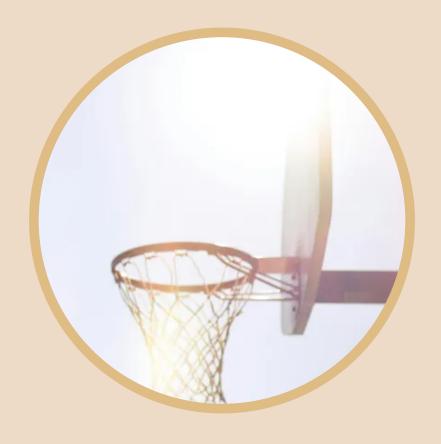

Unity does not mean uniformity, but a harmonious working together, each part valuing the other. This requires intentional effort, patience, and love. Ephesians urges us to pursue unity through the Spirit's bond of peace, while Colossians reminds us love is the glue holding everything together.

On your team, embracing differences creates strength. It fosters respect and encourages every member to play their part, not for personal glory but for the whole team's success and God's glory. Reflect on how well your team celebrates diverse gifts and works toward unity fueled by love.

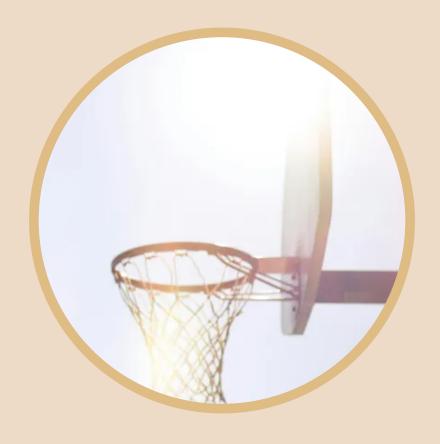
