Devotional: The Foundation of Fellowship in Community

True fellowship helps us grow in this discernment. In godly community, we can seek advice, gain perspective, and be held accountable in our technology use. Friends and mentors provide a sounding board when we're unsure about an app, social media habit, or online content.

Pause today and ask God for wisdom specifically related to your digital life. Where can you invite others to speak into your technology habits? Let fellowship be the setting where wisdom is sought and nurtured, keeping you anchored in what honors God and fosters growth.
