#### Devotional: Strengthening Unity to Amplify Impact

Unity is essential when serving together. Philippians 2:2 emphasizes being like-minded and united in spirit and purpose. In volunteer work, this unity empowers teams to overcome obstacles and maximize impact.

**Each person brings unique gifts**, and when these gifts come together with shared love, the group becomes a strong, loving community that mirrors the Body of Christ (Romans 12:4–5). Ephesians 4:16 reminds us that every supporting ligament matters to keep the body healthy and knit closely.
