Day 1: Gifts as a Divine Calling

#### Your Verse

1 Peter 4:10 – "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms."

- Exodus 35:35 "He has filled them with skill to do every sort of work done by an engraver or by a designer or by an embroiderer..."

#### Devotional: Embracing Gifts as a Sacred Calling

**Every artistic gift is a divine calling** granted by God to enrich the body of Christ. As we recognize that our talents are not accidental but purposeful, it reshapes how we perceive creativity—not as mere hobby, but as sacred ministry. Peter reminds us that these gifts are entrusted to us *to serve others*, not for self-glorification but to build up the community.

Think about the master artists in Scripture, such as Bezalel and Oholiab, who were filled with the Spirit to craft the tabernacle's beauty. Their work was an act of worship and a demonstration of fellowship, as others contributed their parts in creating something holy and communal.

#### Devotional: Harmony in Shared Creativity

#### Devotional: Making Creativity a Living Sacrifice

Creativity is a profound form of worship. When David calls us to sing for joy, it is not just a command but an invitation to express our love and reverence in a vibrant way. Artistic creation occasions an encounter with God, weaving our gifts into living offerings.

The artisans in Exodus remind us that God equips us with creativity intentionally, so that our work reflects His holiness and beauty. Worship is not confined to music or spoken prayers but extends through every act of creating that honors God's presence.

Viewing your artistic gifts as acts of worship transforms the creative process. It shifts focus from performance or perfection to devotion and surrender. Each brushstroke, note, or crafted piece becomes an offering—a way of saying, "You are worthy, Lord." How can your creativity today become a living sacrifice, pleasing and holy before God?

#### Devotional: Art Serving the Community in Love

Fellowship grows stronger when artistic gifts serve the community. Paul's teaching reminds us that our talents are meant for others, encouraging a heart posture of humility and love. Art, when used to serve, ministers beyond words, offering healing, encouragement, and connection.

#### Devotional: Uniting to Glorify God Creatively
