- John 4:39 "Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony."







#### Devotional: The Strength Found in Sharing Our Story

Our personal testimonies are powerful tools in spiritual warfare and encouragement. Revelation 12:11 reveals that believers overcame the enemy "by the word of their testimony." Sharing what God has done in our lives becomes a spiritual weapon, affirming our faith and encouraging others.

Testimonies personalize the abstract truths of faith, showing God's active presence in everyday life. When the woman at the well shared her experience with Jesus, many believed because her story made the truth relatable and authentic (John 4:39).

#### Your Verse

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Galatians 6:2 "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."
- Ecclesiastes 4:9–10 "Two are better than one... If either of them falls down, one can help the other up."

#### Devotional: Shared Vulnerability Strengthens Community Bonds

True fellowship thrives when believers open their hearts and share both triumphs and struggles. James 5:16 encourages us to confess our sins and pray for one another, highlighting that vulnerability leads to healing and spiritual power. When we share honestly, it builds trust and deepens relationships within the body.

Day 3: X Encouragement Through Stories of Faith

#### Devotional: Stories Build Up and Strengthen Believers

**Encouragement is a vital thread weaving through the fabric of healthy fellowship.** Paul exhorts the believers in Thessalonica to "encourage one another and build each other up." Sharing faith stories accomplishes exactly that—strengthening hearts and inspiring continued perseverance.

Hebrews 10:24–25 urges us to spur one another toward love and good deeds, and stories of God's grace motivate us to live out our faith boldly. The early church's testimony in Acts 4:33 demonstrates the grace and power that flowed from their collective witnessing, uplifting the entire community amid trials.

Consider the impact your story can have: When we share moments of God's provision, deliverance, or transformation, we encourage others who may face similar struggles. Each testimony serves as a beacon of hope reminding us that God's faithfulness never fails.

Today, think about how you can intentionally encourage others by sharing your faith journey or uplifting theirs. Let your stories spark hope and build a stronger fellowship.

#### Your Verse

Psalm 95:1-2 - "Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Colossians 3:16 "Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit."
- Revelation 19:7 "Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready."







#### Devotional: United in Praise and Testimony

Worship and testimony are intertwined expressions of our fellowship. Psalm 95 invites us to joyfully sing and give thanks together, celebrating the Rock of our salvation. When believers unite in worship, they create an atmosphere where testimonies naturally flow and faith is strengthened.

Colossians 3:16 reminds us to let the message of Christ dwell richly among us, teaching and encouraging with wisdom through songs and psalms. Worship not only honors God but also provides a communal platform for sharing the good news of His faithfulness.

Think about the connection between worship and testimony: In Revelation 19:7, the church rejoices in preparation for the Lamb's wedding, highlighting the joy and readiness that come from shared faith experiences. Worship strengthens fellowship and fuels the courage to share personal stories of God's work.

Today, engage in worship with an open heart, inviting the Spirit to inspire your testimony and encourage others as you glorify God together.

#### Devotional: Using Our Words to Build Up the Body
