Introduction

Living with chronic hives can be physically exhausting and emotionally draining. The constant discomfort, itching, and unpredictability often lead to frustration, anxiety, and even despair. During such times, it's vital to anchor ourselves in something unshakable — the peace and strength that comes from **God**. This 7-day Bible study plan is designed especially for you who face this ongoing health challenge, to help you experience God's comfort and restoration deeply.

Throughout these days, we'll explore God's promises about His care for your body and soul, His provision of peace beyond understanding, and His strength that sustains when human energy fails. You will be encouraged to cast your burdens on Him, knowing He cares *intimately* about your pain and struggles.

Each day, the Scriptures will remind you that you are not alone. God's Word is alive and active, able to penetrate your heart with hope and healing. Through heartfelt devotionals, reflection questions, and prayer, you will be equipped to invite God's peace to guard your heart and mind and to release your anxieties into His capable hands.

Remember, this journey is not about a quick fix but about growing your faith in the midst of difficulties. It's an invitation to walk with God as your refuge, your healer, and your source of enduring peace. Wherever you are physically







or emotionally right now, know that God sees you, loves you, and wants to meet you with His peace that truly overcomes all fear.

















Your Verse

Psalm 46:1 - God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 34:18 The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.
- Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God.







Devotional: God Is Your Ever-Present Strength and Refuge

Chronic hives can often make you feel vulnerable and isolated. Yet **Psalm 46:1** reminds us that God is our refuge and strength—always present to help us when life's trials overwhelm us. He is not distant or indifferent to your pain; He is an ever-present help, ready to shield and comfort you.

In moments when itching disrupts your sleep or uncertainty clouds your mind, you can lean into God's protection. He feels your struggles deeply and offers a sanctuary from the storm, both physically and emotionally.

Consider **Psalm 34:18** and **Isaiah 41:10** as God's promises whispering to your heart: He is near to your brokenness and commands you not to fear. His strength will uphold you, even in this difficult season.

Today, invite God to be your stronghold. Rest in the assurance that you do not walk this road alone but are held by His loving care.

3.	In what ways can you remind yourself regularly that God is your refuge?

Your Verse

Jeremiah 30:17 – I will restore you to health and heal your wounds, declares the LORD.

Supporting Scriptures

- Exodus 15:26 I am the LORD, who heals you.
- Psalm 103:2-3 Praise the LORD... who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases.







Devotional: God's Promise to Restore and Heal

Chronic hives often make us long for physical healing, and **Jeremiah 30:17** offers a profound promise of restoration. God declares His intention to restore health and heal wounds, both visible and invisible. Even if healing feels distant, His promise remains steadfast.

Exodus 15:26 calls God the healer of His people, and **Psalm 103** celebrates His power to heal diseases. Healing may take different forms — physical relief, emotional peace, or spiritual renewal — but God's desire is to bring restoration in every area of your life.

Hold on to this truth today: God is actively at work, touching your body and soul with His healing hand. Invite Him to mend what is broken and to sustain you in the waiting.

1.	How do you understand God's healing in your current health situation?
2.	What does 'restoration' mean for you beyond physical symptoms?
3.	How can trusting God's healing process strengthen your faith?

1.	Write a prayer asking God for healing in body, mind, or spirit.
2	Deflect on a time Cod brought bealing or rectantion in your life
2.	Reflect on a time God brought healing or restoration in your life.
3.	Describe what hope looks like to you as you await healing.

Supporting Scriptures

- John 14:27 I leave you peace; my peace I give you. Do not let your hearts be troubled.
- Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts.







Devotional: Embracing God's Peace Amidst Chronic Pain

Living with chronic hives can stir anxiety and unrest, but **Philippians 4:7** speaks hope into that space. God offers a peace that surpasses understanding, able to guard your heart and mind despite physical discomfort.

Jesus' words in **John 14:27** remind us that He deliberately leaves us His peace, instructing us not to be troubled. This peace is not dependent on circumstances but rooted in His presence — a peace that can calm storms inside you.

Colossians 3:15 further encourages letting Christ's peace rule in your heart. This means actively inviting His peace in, even when it feels elusive. Today, you can choose to rest in that perfect peace amidst ongoing challenges.

1.	Where do you see anxiety taking hold in your health journey?
2.	How can you practically invite God's peace into those anxious moments?
3.	In what ways does God's peace differ from worldly peace for you?

1.	Describe how God's peace has shown up unexpectedly during pain.
2.	List the worries you want to hand over to God's peace today.
3.	Write about what it feels like to have God's peace guarding your heart.

Your Verse

Isaiah 40:29 - He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Corinthians 12:9 My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.
- Psalm 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart.







Devotional: Relying on God's Strength in Weakness

Chronic illnesses like hives often leave you feeling drained—physically and emotionally. But Isaiah 40:29 reminds us that God provides strength to the weary and power to the weak. When your body fails, His strength uplifts your spirit.

Paul's words in **2 Corinthians 12:9** reveal a profound truth: God's grace is all you need. When you feel weak, His power shines brightest. And **Psalm 73:26** echoes this by declaring God as the strength of our hearts, even when our flesh and heart fail.

Today, lean into God's strength. Admit your weakness honestly and invite His sustaining power to carry you through each difficult moment.

1.	How does your weakness create space for God's strength to work?
2.	What areas do you most need God to empower you in right now?
3.	In what ways can you remind yourself daily of God's sustaining grace?

2.	List areas where you need to surrender control and rely on God.
3.	Describe how God's grace has been sufficient during your illness.

Supporting Scriptures

- Matthew 11:28 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- Psalm 55:22 Cast your cares on the LORD and he will sustain you.







Devotional: Releasing Anxiety into God's Caring Hands

Living with chronic hives can be mentally and emotionally overwhelming. Anxiety about flare-ups, treatments, and future health can weigh heavily on your heart. However, **1 Peter 5:7** grants beautiful permission to cast all your anxieties on God because He cares deeply for you.

Jesus invites weary and burdened souls in **Matthew 11:28** to come to Him for rest, a restful peace that renews your spirit. Similarly, **Psalm 55:22** promises that when you cast your cares onto the Lord, He sustains you and does not let you fall.

Today, identify the specific fears or worries pressing on your heart. Gently hand them over to God, trusting in His loving care and faithfulness. Lay your burdens at His feet and receive His rest.







Reflect and Apply

1.	What anxieties about your health can you bring honestly before God?
2.	How does trusting in God's care affect your ability to let go of worries?
3.	What does resting in God look like for you practically each day?







Journaling Prompts

1.	Write down your biggest worries related to chronic hives and give them to God.
2.	Reflect on how God has sustained you in previous struggles.
3.	Describe what resting in God's care feels like emotionally and spiritually.

Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him.
- Hebrews 10:23 He is faithful; he will do it.







Devotional: Renewed Hope Through God's Steadfast Love

The journey with chronic hives can sometimes feel like an unending trial. Yet God's faithfulness remains steadfast, His mercies fresh every day, as declared in **Lamentations 3:22–23**. Even on the hardest days, God does not consume you because His compassion never fails.

Romans 15:13 encourages us to be filled with hope, joy, and peace as we trust in God. And **Hebrews 10:23** assures us that God keeps His promises; He is faithful to complete what He begins.

Today, let hope rise in your heart by focusing on God's unchanging character. No matter how your body feels, His love and faithfulness are your firm foundation. Trust Him anew this morning.

3.	What hopes do you want to nurture through trusting God more deeply?
