Psalm 34:18 – "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

Supporting Scriptures

- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."







Devotional: God Is Near to Those Who Hurt

In our moments of physical suffering, it's easy to feel isolated and overwhelmed. Tendonitis and movement pain can drain our energy and spirit, making everyday tasks daunting. Yet, the Bible reassures us that God never distances Himself when we hurt. *Psalm 34:18 beautifully portrays the Lord's nearness to the brokenhearted.* This promise is a firm foundation for anyone enduring chronic pain or inflammation.

Your Verse

Isaiah 40:29 - "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."

Supporting Scriptures

- Nehemiah 8:10 "The joy of the Lord is your strength."







Devotional: God Bolsters Our Weakness with Strength

Physical pain often leads to exhaustion, draining not just muscles but also emotional stamina. The prophet Isaiah reminds us of God's promise to provide strength to the weary and empower the weak. When tendonitis cramps your movement and your energy wanes, take heart in this divine assurance.

Strength comes not only in physical perseverance but also through the joy and peace rooted in a relationship with God. Psalm 73:26 acknowledges our flesh and hearts may falter, yet God remains our unfailing source of strength.

Your Verse

1 Corinthians 6:19–20 – "Your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit... Therefore honor God with your body."

Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 12:1 "Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God."
- Proverbs 3:7–8 "Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil. This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones."







Devotional: Honoring God by Caring for Our Bodies

Our bodies, though fragile at times, are sacred vessels entrusted to us by God. 1 Corinthians reminds us that our bodies are the temple of the Holy Spirit and that we should honor God through how we care for them.

When experiencing tendonitis or movement pain, caring for your body can feel frustrating or limited. Yet even in these restrictions, you can honor God by practicing patience, gentle care, and mindful nourishment.

Romans encourages us to offer our bodies as a living sacrifice, which means honoring God through rest, recovery, and wise choices. Proverbs teaches us that reverence for God contributes to physical well-being. Your commitment to care for your health is also a spiritual act of worship.

Your Verse

Jeremiah 30:17 – "I will restore you to health and heal your wounds," declares the Lord.

Supporting Scriptures

- Exodus 15:26 "I am the Lord, who heals you."
- Psalm 147:3 "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."







Day 4: // Healing and Restoration Promise

Devotional: God's Promise to Heal and Restore

One of the most comforting promises for those enduring pain is God's assurance of healing and restoration. Jeremiah declares God's commitment to restoring health and healing wounds, which includes both physical and emotional suffering.

While tendonitis and movement pain may not always disappear overnight, God's healing can be a continual process of renewal and hope. Exodus reminds us that God is the ultimate healer, and Psalm 147 encourages us that He tenderly cares for our brokenness.

Hold this promise close today. God's healing presence is with you even in seasons of discomfort and long recovery.

Your Verse

John 14:27 - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives."

Supporting Scriptures

- Philippians 4:6-7 "Do not be anxious about anything... the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts."
- Isaiah 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast because they trust in you."







Day 5: W Peace in the Midst of Pain

Devotional: Embracing Jesus' Peace in Pain

Physical pain can often steal our peace, causing anxiety and fear. Jesus offers a different kind of peace—one that the world cannot give or take away.

When tendonitis or movement pain threatens to overwhelm your thoughts and emotions, lean into the peace that Jesus freely offers. Philippians encourages us not to be anxious but to bring every concern to God in prayer, allowing His peace to guard our hearts and minds.

Your Verse

James 1:2-4 - "Consider it pure joy... whenever you face trials, because the testing of your faith produces perseverance."

Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 5:3-5 "Suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope."
- Hebrews 12:1 "Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us."







Devotional: Joy and Strength in Persevering Faith

Enduring persistent pain requires perseverance, a steadfastness of spirit that grows through trials. James calls us to consider our difficulties as opportunities to develop unwavering faith.

Tendonitis and movement restrictions may feel like setbacks, but they can also refine your character and deepen your hope in God. Romans highlights how suffering leads to perseverance, which builds character and sustains hope.

Fix your eyes on Jesus and press forward, even when the path is difficult. Your endurance is not in vain—God uses every trial to shape and strengthen you.

What tools help you persevere when suffering feels overwhelming?
How does hope fuel your faith during ongoing health challenges?

Prayer for Today

Your Verse

Revelation 21:4 - "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain."

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 61:3 "...to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes... and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair."
- 2 Corinthians 4:16–18 "Our outer self is wasting away, but our inner self is being renewed day by day."







Devotional: Hope in God's Ultimate Restoration

As this study concludes, we look forward to the eternal hope God offers—a future without pain, suffering, or sorrow. Revelation reveals the glorious promise that God will one day wipe away every tear and bring perfect restoration.

Meanwhile, Isaiah encourages us to exchange despair for praise, recognizing God's ongoing work to renew our hearts. Though the body may face limits today, 2 Corinthians reminds us that our inner self is renewed daily by God's Spirit.

Cling to hope and live each day with praise, trusting God's ultimate plan for wholeness. Your pain does not define you—God's love does.
