Day 1: A Facing the Pain of Loss

#### Devotional: God Is Near to the Brokenhearted

Grief often feels like a crushing weight pressing down on your heart, a pain so raw it seems unbearable. Yet God assures us that He is near to those who are brokenhearted. **He does not turn away from our tears or pain**; instead, He draws close, offering comfort and healing in the midst of sorrow.

Being widowed is a profound loss, and it's okay to acknowledge feelings of emptiness, anger, or confusion. The psalmist's words remind you that God is not distant—He saves those who feel crushed in spirit and begins the work of healing, even when the path is unclear.

Today, allow yourself to be honest before God about your pain. You don't have to carry this burden alone. Invite Him to walk with you, to heal wounds slowly and tenderly. Take comfort that while grief is natural, you have a compassionate God who understands and will never leave you alone in your pain.

#### Prayer for Today

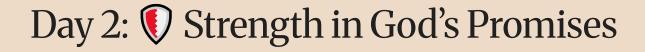

#### Devotional: Renewed Strength Comes Through Hope

He is your refuge in trouble and your ever-present helper, ready to carry you through moments when life feels too hard to bear.

Rest in the assurance that as you hope in God, you will find renewed courage and resilience to face each new day. Your weakness is not a barrier but a divine opportunity to experience God's perfect strength.

#### Devotional: Embracing Jesus' Peace in Grief

#### Devotional: Healing in God's Comforting Community

Grief feels isolating, but God designed us for relationship and community. The God of all comfort not only heals us but also equips us to comfort others. As you process your loss, **remember that you don't have to walk alone.** 

Other believers are meant to come alongside—to listen, bear burdens, and lift you up when you stumble. Sometimes, accepting help and sharing your story can be difficult, especially for men who may feel pressure to be self-reliant. Yet Scripture encourages mutual care as a reflection of Christ's love.

Today, consider who God may be using as a source of comfort in your life. And as you heal, think about how your experience might one day offer hope or consolation to others. Community is a vital part of God's healing plan—lean in, receive, and be prepared to give back.
