Devotional: Finding Security in God's Protection

Day 2: V Joy in God's Goodness

Devotional: Recognizing All Good Comes From God

David's declaration today is a profound recognition of God's ultimate goodness. By saying there is no good thing apart from God, he expresses that true joy and blessing originate solely from Him. This is a spiritual truth that reorients our perspective away from fleeting pleasures to the enduring goodness of God.

Devotional: Listening for God's Wise Guidance

Devotional: God as Our Secure Portion and Cup
