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Introduction

Over the next three days, you'll encounter Scriptures that reveal the heart of obedience, be encouraged by devotional insights, and engage in meaningful reflection and prayer. Devotional: Embrace Joy by Delighting in God's Word

Delighting in God's Word is the foundation of joyful obedience. Psalm 119:16 encapsulates the psalmist's deep affection and commitment to God's decrees. It's not about obligation but about finding true pleasure in the truths God reveals. When God's Word becomes our constant companion, it influences how we perceive life, guiding us to live in ways that honor Him and bless our souls.

How can we cultivate this delight? Begin by setting aside time to read and meditate on Scripture daily. Instead of rushing through, savor the promises and the wisdom. Let God's words transform your heart by focusing not on the rules themselves, but on the loving character of God behind them. As you grow in understanding, obedience becomes a joyful expression of love rather than a legalistic duty.

Remember, the psalmist's delight led to refusal to neglect God's Word. May we too cherish it above distractions and challenges. When we discover the joy in obedience, our lives become a living testimony of faithfulness and peace.

Devotional: Wholehearted Surrender Brings Delight

Surrender is the key to unlocking true and lasting joy in obedience. Psalm 119:35 shows the psalmist asking God to guide him in His paths, emphasizing that delight is found when we follow God's commands fully. Obedience isn't about partial compliance or selective following; it's a wholehearted surrender that aligns our will with God's.

James reminds us of the importance of putting the Word into practice. Listening is not enough—joy flows when we live it out consistently. Jesus teaches that keeping His commands keeps us in His love, an intimate and powerful source of joy.

When we surrender our own desires and choices to God, we position ourselves to experience the abundant life He promises. This surrender may be challenging, but the result is a profound joy and peace that the world cannot give or take away.
