Devotional: God Is Near When You Are Hurting

Feeling abandoned can make your heart feel broken and crushed. But Psalm 34:18 reminds us that God is very close to us especially when we hurt the most. He understands your pain deeply because He cares more than anyone else can.

Sometimes abandonment leaves a hole that feels impossible to fill, but God's presence is the true comfort. He promises He will not leave you alone, like an orphan. You can lean on Him today with your sadness and fears.

Try to imagine God wrapping His loving arms around you right now—He is near, even in your darkest moments. Though your earthly parent may have left, God's love is unfailing and forever.

3.	List times when you have felt God's presence despite your struggles.







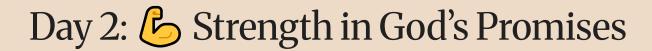
Prayer for Today

Devotional: Renewed Strength Through Hope in God

When your world feels shaky because of abandonment, God's promises are solid ground. Isaiah 40:31 teaches us that hoping in the Lord renews our strength. This means when your heart feels weak and tired, God can lift you up like an eagle soaring high above troubles.

It's okay to feel weak sometimes—God's grace meets you there and transforms your weakness into power. Lean on Him instead of your own strength in moments of despair.

Remember, God's power uplifts you so you can keep moving forward even when life feels overwhelming.

Devotional: Unshakable Love From God

When a parent abandons you, it may be easy to question your worth and love. But Romans 8:38–39 assures us that absolutely nothing can separate you from God's love—not even the deepest hurts.

God's love is everlasting and unconditional. He sees and cherishes you no matter what, calling you His beloved child. Let go of the lies that say you are abandoned or unloved.

Allow God's truth to fill your heart today: You are valuable, deeply loved, and chosen by your Heavenly Father forever.

Day 4: **(**) Protection in God's Care

Devotional: Safe Shelter Under God's Wings

Feeling abandoned often comes with fear—fear of being alone or unsafe.

Psalm 91:4 gives a beautiful picture of God's protection like a bird covering her young under her wings to keep them safe.

You can run to God as your strong tower and refuge. He is faithful to guard you from harm and strengthen you in difficult times.

Knowing you have a divine shelter can calm your fears and give you courage to face each day.

Day 5: F Growing Through Healing

Devotional: God's Gentle Healing Process

Healing after abandonment doesn't usually happen overnight. God recognizes your pain and promises restoration and healing for your wounds.

You are invited to bring your weariness and brokenness to Jesus, who offers rest and renewal. The process might take time, but each day can bring growth toward inner peace and emotional recovery.

Allow yourself to move at your own pace, knowing God is gently restoring your heart.
