Psalm 34:18 - The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

- Matthew 5:4 Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- Revelation 21:4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes.







#### Devotional: God Is Close to the Brokenhearted

Loss that touches a child's life is unimaginable, and the initial shock often leaves the heart shattered. It is okay to acknowledge your grief fully, for God draws near to the brokenhearted—not away from them. Psalm 34:18 reminds us that God doesn't distance Himself but steps closely beside those who are crushed in spirit. This presence is not a promise of quick healing but a pledge that you will never walk alone in your anguish.

#### Devotional: Embracing God's Comfort in Grief

**During overwhelming grief**, it feels as though no comfort can reach the heart's deepest ache. Yet, God is called the "God of all comfort." His comfort is tailor-made for our hurt, gently wrapping around our spirit in times of trouble. 2 Corinthians 1:3–4 reveals that God comforts us so that we can one day offer comfort to others — a process of healing and strengthening through shared pain.

As you grieve the unexpected loss of your child, remember God's promise in Isaiah 41:10—He is with you, your unwavering strength. He does not ask you to be fearless but to rely on His presence. Psalm 147:3 illustrates His intimate involvement in healing wounds that seem impossible to mend.

*Lean into God's refuge today*, allowing His comfort to soothe the broken places within you. Let Him bind up your wounds and renew your hope even when despair seems to linger.

#### Devotional: The Healing Power of Tears

**Grieving is not a linear process** or a burden to hide. Instead, it is an essential part of healing. Ecclesiastes reminds us that there is a time for every emotion, including weeping and mourning—both vital parts of grief. Sometimes the world expects quick recovery, but Scripture encourages us to recognize and honor the season of sorrow.

Jesus, who is fully God and fully human, wept at the death of His friend Lazarus (John 11:35). This simple act shows that tears are honorable and necessary. Psalm 30:5 acknowledges the reality of darkness in grief but promises the hope of joy with the dawn.

Give yourself permission today to feel deeply, cry freely, and mourn authentically. Your grief is a testament to the love you carry in your heart and an invitation to trust God to walk with you through each shadowed moment.

#### Devotional: Renewed Strength Through Hope in God

**Loss can leave us feeling drained** with little energy to face each new day. But God promises renewal for those who place their hope in Him. Isaiah 40:31 offers assurance that trusting the Lord revitalizes weary hearts and minds.

Psalm 46:1 paints a picture of God as a refuge and source of strength, everpresent when we encounter feared and unfamiliar emotions. Sometimes strength is not about pushing through alone but resting in God's power instead of our own.

Philippians 4:13 reminds believers that the strength needed to persevere doesn't come from within but through Christ living in them. When grief feels overwhelming, lean into Jesus, who is your empowering strength to face the unknowns ahead.

Today, choose to place your hope and trust fully in God's sustaining promises. Let Him renew your strength when you feel weak.

Jesus promised in John 14 that He is preparing a place for all who believe, a comforting promise for those mourning the loss of a child. 1 Thessalonians tells us that Christians grieve with hope, trusting that death is not the final word.

Though the pain is real and raw, holding on to this hope gently reshapes our sorrow into peace and assurance. It invites us to remember that love transcends even death and that reunion awaits beyond this life.

#### Devotional: God Transforms Mourning Into Joy

In the midst of grief, joy can feel distant or even impossible to imagine. Yet Scripture reveals that God does not abandon His children in their sorrow. Psalm 30 recounts how God can transform mourning into dancing, turning despair into delight over time.

Nehemiah reminds us joy itself is a powerful source of strength from the Lord, especially during hard seasons. Jesus reassures believers in John 16 that grief will ultimately give way to joy — a promise that is both comforting and hopeful.

While you may still weep, be open to moments when God brings laughter, peace, or gratefulness back into your life. It might be slowly and quietly, but joy is not erased by grief; it is restored through the loving hand of God.
