Psalm 91:1 – "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty."

- Proverbs 18:10 "The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe."
- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."







Day 1: ① God's Shelter and Protection

Devotional: Resting Securely Under God's Shadow

Psalm 91:1 opens with a powerful image: dwelling in the shelter of the Most High and resting in His shadow. This speaks of intimate, ongoing relationship —living safely under God's protection, like a bird resting quietly beneath a shelter.

To 'dwell' means more than just occasional seeking; it implies a constant, committed presence with God. In a world full of dangers, uncertainties, and fears, God invites us to come near and find safety and peace in Him alone.

Just as a shadow offers cool relief from the harsh sun, God's protective presence shields us from the heat and harm of life's challenges. This promise encourages us to trust God daily, not just in crises but in every moment.

Consider how often you seek refuge in God or try to find security elsewhere. Today, commit to making God your immediate place of safety—a refuge you return to constantly for sustenance and peace.

- Lamentations 3:22–23 "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."







Day 2: W God's Faithfulness and Deliverance

Devotional: Confidence in God's Unfailing Faithfulness

Psalm 91:4

God's faithfulness is described as a shield and rampart—a robust defense against all threats. This faithfulness is central to our confidence. Despite trials or threats, God's commitment to keep His promises remains unshaken.

Consider how faithfulness transforms your relationship with God. Knowing that God will never abandon or fail you enables you to face life's storms without fear.

Your Verse

Psalm 91:14-15 - "Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name. He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him."

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."
- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."







Devotional: Trusting God's Rescue in Times of Trouble

In these closing verses of Psalm 91, God declares His promise to personally rescue and protect those who love Him and call on His name. There is a deep assurance here: God will answer your prayers, be present in your troubles, deliver you, and bring you honor.
