Your Verse

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 - Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 34:18 The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.
- Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God.







Devotional: God's Compassion Brings Comfort and Strength

Living with COPD can often feel isolating and overwhelming, with each breath a reminder of physical limits. Yet the Bible reminds us that God is our ultimate source of comfort and compassion. He understands our struggles intimately and offers His presence as a healing balm for our tired souls.

Paul's words in 2 Corinthians acknowledge that God not only comforts us but also equips us to comfort others through our experiences. Recognizing God's nearness during tough times transforms our trials into testimonies.

When you feel weak or fearful, remember that God's compassion is constant. He is the God who draws near to the brokenhearted—never distant or indifferent. Allow His peace to permeate your spirit today, even amid uncertainty. Take a moment to invite Him into every breath and rest in His sustaining love.

Your Verse

Isaiah 40:29–31 – He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.
- Matthew 11:28 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.







Devotional: Renewed Strength Through Hope in God

Chronic illness often drains physical and emotional energy, but God promises renewal for those who place their hope in Him. Isaiah paints a beautiful picture of soaring on eagle's wings — a metaphor for supernatural strength beyond our human capacity.

Though your COPD may limit your physical stamina, your spirit can be renewed daily through God's power. When fatigue presses in, turn to the Lord with faith. Receive His restorative grace that refreshes our inner being and equips us to face each day.

This passage invites us into a posture of hope — looking upward and trusting that God renews strength not only in body but in spirit and mind. Let yourself be revitalized by His faithful promises.

2.	Write prayers asking God to increase your hope and endurance.
3.	Reflect on ways you can lean more fully on God in your health journey.

Your Verse

Psalm 103:2-4 - Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion.

Supporting Scriptures

- Jeremiah 30:17 I will restore you to health and heal your wounds.
- James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord.







Devotional: Embracing God's Healing and Compassion

It can be difficult to reconcile chronic illness with the hope of healing, but Scripture reminds us God is the ultimate healer — both physically and spiritually. Psalm 103 praises God for forgiving, healing, redeeming, and crowning us with love. This holistic healing includes more than just our bodies; it encompasses our souls and minds as well.

Even if COPD remains a persistent challenge, God's healing presence never leaves us. His compassion envelops us daily. The Bible encourages us to seek prayer and anointing, demonstrating the power of community and faith in God's healing work.

Remember that God's healing may look different than we expect — it can be emotional peace, greater patience, or acceptance alongside physical care. Trust that He is at work in every facet of your circumstance.

- Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this.







Devotional: Resting in God's Sovereign Goodness

Living with COPD brings many uncertainties: fluctuating symptoms, treatments, and lifestyle changes. It's natural to wrestle with questions about purpose and meaning amid these trials.

Romans 8:28 offers a powerful truth: God is orchestrating all things — even difficulties — for our good and His glory. This doesn't mean every moment is easy, but rather that God's sovereign hand is guiding our stories toward ultimate hope.

By trusting God wholeheartedly and surrendering our limited understanding, we position ourselves to experience His peace and direction. COPD may redefine your daily life, but God's purpose does not waver.

Commit your health journey into His capable hands today, and rest in the certainty that He is working all things for a divine purpose you may not yet see.

Today, seek small moments of gratitude and God's joy, trusting He will sustain you emotionally and spiritually through every breath.

- Isaiah 26:3 You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.







Day 6: 🔼 Peace That Calms the Breath

Devotional: Receiving Jesus' Perfect Peace Today

Shortness of breath and uncertainty from COPD can stir anxiety and unrest. Jesus offers a peace unlike anything this world can give — a peace that calms the heart and mind amid storms.

When fear threatens, bring your concerns to God in prayer, trusting He hears you and offers perfect peace. This peace is an active, sustaining presence that guards your heart even when circumstances remain difficult.

God's peace enables you to breathe easier spiritually, even if physical breathing remains labored. Allow His promises to soothe anxiety and strengthen your hope.
