#### Your Verse

Psalm 139:14 – "I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Genesis 1:27 "So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them."
- Jeremiah 1:5 "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart..."







Day 1: Fembracing God's Creation

#### Devotional: You Are Wonderfully Made

Feeling unsure about yourself? It's normal as a teen to ask, "Who am I really?" Today, Scripture reminds us that God doesn't just make things by accident—He crafted you intentionally and wonderfully! In Psalm 139:14, David proclaims God's handiwork in himself, highlighting a truth you can stand on: you are precious, unique, and made with purpose.

The world might try to tell you that your worth depends on looks, popularity, or abilities—but God's perspective is different. You bear His image, created to reflect His glory. This means your identity is deeply rooted in being God's masterpiece. When you embrace this truth, you begin to see yourself through God's eyes, not the world's.

Today, take some time to celebrate your uniqueness and thank God for making you exactly as you are. You're fearfully and wonderfully made!

#### Your Verse

Galatians 3:28 – "There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Colossians 3:3 "For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God."
- 1 Samuel 16:7 "The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."







Day 2: **(**) Identity Beyond Labels

#### Devotional: More Than Labels and Roles

Who are you beyond the names and labels people place on you? Teen years often come with pressure to fit certain groups or live up to expectations. Sometimes, these labels can feel like chains, making you unsure of your true identity.

Galatians 3:28 reminds us that in Christ, none of these distinctions matter. Your race, gender, or social status does not define your value. Instead, your identity is rooted in being united with Jesus. When you accept Christ, you begin a new journey where you are loved unconditionally.

Outward labels can be confusing and fleeting, but your heart's identity in God remains firm. Today, ask God to help you see beyond superficial categories and embrace who He says you are—a beloved child of God. This will free you to live with confidence and peace, no longer confined by others' opinions.

#### Your Verse

2 Timothy 1:7 - "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 34:4 "I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears."
- Romans 8:38–39 "Nothing... can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."







#### Devotional: Power to Overcome Fear and Doubt

**Insecurity and doubt can cloud a teenager's mind.** You might fear rejection or feel powerless in the face of challenges. But God offers a different story—one of strength, love, and courage through His Spirit.

2 Timothy 1:7 tells us that God's Spirit gives us power, love, and self-discipline, not fear. This means no matter how confused you feel about your identity, God's spirit empowers you to stand strong.

When fear creeps in, turn to God's promises. He delivers from fear and surrounds us with unbreakable love. Reflect on the times God has helped you overcome worries. With His presence, insecurity loses power and you can claim your worth boldly.

#### Prayer for Today

#### Your Verse

Jeremiah 29:11 – "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works..."
- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart... He will make your paths straight."







#### Devotional: Living Out God's Purpose for You

**Identity confusion often comes from not knowing our purpose.** But God's Word assures us that He has good plans for our lives. Jeremiah 29:11 promises a hopeful future that God is actively working toward.

You are not here by accident. Like Ephesians 2:10 says, you were created for good works—special things only you can do. When we trust God with our path (Proverbs 3:5-6), He guides us through uncertainty.

Knowing your purpose brings clarity and confidence to your identity. It can calm the chaos and help you see yourself as a valued part of God's story. Lean on God today as you seek to uncover His plan uniquely designed for you.

What excites you about the idea that God has a plan just for you?
How can trusting God in uncertain times help you feel more secure in your identity?
What steps can you take to discover and live out God's purpose in your life?

Romans 12:2 - "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind..."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Philippians 4:8 "Whatever is true, noble... think about such things."
- Joshua 1:9 "Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."







#### Devotional: Renew Your Mind with God's Truth

What we tell ourselves matters. Negative thoughts about worth or identity can trap us in confusion and doubt. But God's Word calls us to a different mindset —one renewed by truth.

Romans 12:2 encourages us to avoid fitting into the world's patterns and instead be transformed by God's truth renewing our minds. This means rejecting lies and intentionally focusing on what is true and good, as Paul advises in Philippians 4:8.

Speaking God's promises over yourself rewires your heart and mind. It builds courage and peace (Joshua 1:9). Today, practice replacing negative thoughts with Scripture or affirmations rooted in God's Word. Let His truth shape your identity.

2.	How can memorizing or speaking Scripture affect your mindset?
3.	Who can encourage you in speaking God's truth daily?

2.	List lies you hear about yourself and replace them with God's truth.
3.	Describe how it feels when you meditate on God's promises.







#### Prayer for Today

Father, help me to recognize and reject lies about myself. Renew my mind with Your Word so that my thoughts align with Your truth. Teach me to speak life and courage over myself daily. May Your Spirit strengthen me to live confidently as Your child. Amen. 🔷 💬 🙏 🖓

#### Devotional: Finding Strength in Community

**Identity is not meant to be formed alone.** God designed us to live in community, where relationships offer strength, accountability, and encouragement.

Ecclesiastes 4:9 illustrates the power of companionship: two working together have greater success. Likewise, Proverbs 27:17 tells us that friends sharpen and help us grow, shaping our character and understanding.

When feeling confused about who you are, lean on trusted friends, family, or mentors. They can remind you of God's truth and support your journey toward clarity and confidence. Seek relationships that build you up and reflect God's love.

#### Devotional: Embrace Your New Identity Boldly

After journeying through questions and confusion, it's time to celebrate the new identity you have in Christ. 2 Corinthians 5:17 declares that being in Christ makes you a new creation—the past no longer defines you.

God is continually working in you (Philippians 1:6) and loves you deeply (1 John 3:1). This truth empowers you to live boldly and confidently.

Let go of old doubts and step into the freedom and joy of who God says you are. Celebrate the transformation He has begun and trust in His ongoing work. Your identity is secure, cherished, and full of hope.
