Devotional: Your True Identity is Found in Christ

Who am I? It's a question every teen asks at some point. The world often tries to define us by popularity, achievements, or appearance—but God offers a different identity. In 1 Peter 2:9, God calls you "a chosen people" and "His special possession." This is a reminder that your worth comes from being created and loved by Him, not by what others say or think.

Devotional: You Have a Unique Role to Play
