#### Devotional: Friendship as a Tool for Spiritual Growth

True friends sharpen and strengthen each other. The image of iron sharpening iron reminds us that healthy friendships are not just comforting —they challenge us to grow and become better. As a teen, you face many decisions and pressures, and having friends who encourage your faith journey is vital. #### Devotional: The Strength of Shared Prayer

**Prayer is a powerful bond that connects Christian friends.** When we come together to pray, Jesus promises to be in the midst of our fellowship. This means that shared prayer isn't just about asking for things — it's about experiencing God's presence together, lifting each other up, and growing in faith as a community.

Prayer in fellowship means opening your heart honestly, supporting your friends in their struggles, and celebrating their joys. It also invites accountability because when we confess our struggles and sins to trusted friends, healing and growth can take place. You don't have to carry burdens alone.

As teens, this can sometimes be intimidating — praying out loud or sharing personal needs. But when you take steps to pray with friends regularly, your confidence increases and those friendships deepen. You will see God work in ways that surprise you and feel the strength that comes from being part of a praying community.

#### Devotional: Encouragement Through Accountability

Christian friends help hold us accountable and cheer us on. Sometimes the best friends are those who lovingly remind us when we stray from God's path. Accountability can be challenging but is a vital part of healthy friendships and spiritual growth.

The writer of Hebrews reminds us not to give up meeting together because fellowship fuels encouragement and motivation to do good. When you build friendships based on love and faith, you create a support network for tough days, struggles with sin, and moments when your faith feels weak.

Encouragement goes hand-in-hand with accountability. It's not just correcting, but also uplifting and inspiring each other to grow. When you embrace this balance, you mirror the heart of Christ to your friends and invite growth for everyone involved. Ask God to guide you to friends who will spur you on and to be that friend in return.
