#### Devotional: God's Strength Fills Our Weakness

When we feel drained and powerless, God's promise becomes our lifeline. Isaiah's words remind us that God doesn't just sympathize with our exhaustion—He actively strengthens us. In moments of weakness, His power can rise within us in ways we never imagined.

The apostle Paul echoes this truth, sharing how God's grace is enough, even when our own resources fail. Rather than hiding our weaknesses, Paul embraced them as opportunities for God's power to shine. Here, we learn a vital lesson: our breakdown can be God's setup for breakthrough through His strength working in and through us.

**Take heart today.** Reflect on areas where you feel weak or overwhelmed, and know God is ready to empower you. Lean into His strength, and watch how your limitations give way to His mighty power and lasting peace.

- Psalm 42:11 'Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him.'







#### Devotional: Joyful Hope Sustains the Soul

**Trials test our faith but also refine it.** Paul encourages believers to remain joyful in hope, even when circumstances are painful. This joy is not superficial happiness but a deep-rooted confidence that God is working all things for good.

James reminds us that trials produce perseverance, shaping a stronger and mature faith. Feeling downcast or overwhelmed is natural, as the psalmist admits. Yet, the antidote is to continually place our hope in God.

**Today, choose joy and hope as anchors for your soul.** Let prayer keep you connected to God and faith keep you persevering. Even when it feels impossible, hope lights the path forward to the miracles God desires to bring.

#### Devotional: Rejoicing in God's Deliverance

After waiting and enduring, breakthrough comes! The psalmist's joy at being heard and delivered echoes the joyful relief we long for during hard times. God's power to intervene is often dramatic, like the parting of the Red Sea or delivering Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego from the fiery furnace unscathed.

Breakthroughs may look different for everyone—sometimes sudden, sometimes subtle—but they always reveal God's faithfulness and power.

Today, celebrate the victories God has already brought and those on the horizon. Remember past breakthroughs as encouragements to keep trusting. Allow gratitude to fill your heart and inspire your faith as you continue your miracle journey.
