Devotional: Root Your Confidence in God's Intentional Love

Being a teen can stir many thoughts about who you are and where you fit in. The voices around you may tell you to look a certain way, act a certain way, or be someone different — but God's Word offers a different and powerful perspective.

Psalm 139:13–14 reminds us that God created us intentionally and wonderfully. You're not a mistake, and your value isn't tied to popularity or appearance. Your identity is rooted in the Creator who lovingly formed every part of you. Jeremiah 1:5 assures that God has known and chosen you even before your birth. This means your worth is grounded in His plan and love, not in fleeting opinions from peers.

When insecurities creep in, take a moment to remember these truths: You are fearfully and wonderfully made. You are chosen. You belong. Let these truths wash over you today, and breathe out the lies that say otherwise. Your confidence starts here — in knowing your God-given identity.

Your Verse

Isaiah 41:10 - "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."
- Psalm 27:1 "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?"







Devotional: God's Strength Dispels Fear and Insecurity

Fear and doubt can often shake our confidence, especially as teens facing social pressures or uncertainty about the future. Isaiah 41:10 is a powerful reminder that God is present with us, offering strength and support that never fades. When insecurities whisper 'you can't,' remember that God says, 'I will strengthen you.'

God's Spirit equips us not with timidity but with power, love, and self-discipline (2 Timothy 1:7). This means you are empowered to face challenges and reject fear. When you feel overwhelmed by opinions or comparisons, lean on the fact that the Lord is your light and salvation. Fear loses its grip when you fix your eyes on Him (Psalm 27:1).

This day, practice calling on God's strength. Let His presence be your shield and your courage. Confidence comes alive as you keep reminding yourself that you are never alone and never outmatched — God is with you every step.

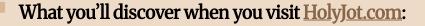
