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Introduction

As a man initially timid and doubting, Gideon became a mighty instrument of God's deliverance for Israel—demonstrating that victory comes not through numbers or strength but through faith and obedience. *God calls the weak to shame the strong* (1 Corinthians 1:27), and Gideon's story is a vivid testament to this truth.

Over the next three weeks, we'll walk through Gideon's experience moment-by-moment, uncovering God's character, the lessons about trust, courage, and surrender, the strategies God used to bring about victory, and how these lessons apply to our daily lives. Whether you feel small, weak, or fearful in your circumstances, this study will encourage you to lean on God's power which is perfect when our strength is lacking (2 Corinthians 12:9). Each day offers a focused devotional to deepen your understanding, reflection questions to engage your heart, and journaling prompts to aid spiritual growth.

Imagine facing overwhelming odds yet seeing God's miraculous intervention! That's what Gideon and his 300 men experienced. Their story reminds us that God is not limited by human abilities and that He delights to display His glory through unexpected means. As you progress through this study, I encourage you to pray, seek the Holy Spirit's guidance, and open your







heart to the transformative power of God's Word. *May this journey deepen your faith and embolden you to trust God's strength in your weakest moments.*

Devotional: God Calls Us Beyond Our Fears

Gideon's story begins with a divine encounter. Hidden among the threshing grain, afraid of the Midianites, Gideon felt insignificant and fearful. Yet an angel called him a "mighty warrior"—a promise not based on Gideon's present condition but on God's purpose for him. This reminds us that God's call often comes when we feel inadequate.

God meets us in our fear and equips us for His plans. Like Gideon, we may doubt ourselves, but God's strength is made perfect in our weakness (2 Corinthians 12:9). Instead of running from fear, Gideon began to listen and obey. This first step of faith launches the path to victory.

Reflect on where fear holds you back. God calls you beyond your doubts to trust in His presence, power, and purpose.

When we recognize our insufficiency, we invite God's sufficiency. This fragile space of humility is where God's grace flourishes. For Gideon, accepting his weakness was not defeat but the start of supernatural empowerment.

Consider your own weaknesses. Are you resisting them, or can you embrace them as places for God to display His power?

God honors honest seeking and invites us into partnership through obedience. Sometimes trust grows little by little, and it's okay to ask for signs as we learn to listen more closely.

When faced with ambiguity, do you patiently wait on God or rush ahead? Gideon's example invites us to cultivate patience and faith in the journey.

God's plans often seem unorthodox, but when followed with faith, they lead to triumph. Our role is to obey, leaving results in God's hands.

Praise and bold declaration can be powerful weapons in spiritual battles. Shouting was an act of trust declaring that God was with them.
