## Devotional: You Are Wonderfully Made by God

#### Your Verse

Jeremiah 1:5 – "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."

## **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 49:1 "Before I was born the Lord called me; from my mother's womb he has spoken my name."
- Galatians 1:15 "But when God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me by his grace, was pleased."







Day 2: F Known and Loved Before Birth

#### Devotional: God Loved You Before You Were Born

God's love for you began even before you took your first breath. Jeremiah 1:5 reminds us that God knew you intimately before you were ever born. This means He had a plan and purpose for your life long before you arrived.

It's comforting to know that from the very beginning, God set you apart. You were not random or forgotten; you were called by name and assigned a mission unique to you. Sometimes we may feel invisible or unimportant, but God's Word says otherwise. You are deeply known and cherished.

## Prayer for Today

#### Your Verse

Isaiah 64:8 – "Yet you, Lord, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand."

## **Supporting Scriptures**

- Job 10:8-9 "Your hands shaped me and made me. Will you now turn and destroy me? Remember that you molded me like clay."
- Romans 9:21 "Does not the potter have the right to make out of the same lump of clay some pottery for special purposes and some for common use?"







## Devotional: God's Intentional Craftsmanship Shapes You

The imagery of a potter shaping clay reminds us that God is intentional in how He creates each one of us. Just as a potter carefully molds a vessel for a special purpose, God has intentionally crafted you with unique traits, talents, and seasons in mind.

Sometimes, life's challenges or comparisons may cause us to feel like 'defective' pottery, but Scripture reminds us that God's hands are always shaping and refining us. This process reflects God's loving care and His desire for us to fulfill the unique role He has designed.

Embrace the idea that you are a masterpiece being formed with intention. Your imperfections do not disqualify you; they highlight a work in progress. Trust the potter's hands, knowing He is creating something valuable and beautiful in you.

	What special purpose might God be preparing you for through your experiences?







## **Journaling Prompts**

1.	Write about a time when you felt God was shaping you through challenges.
2.	List qualities or gifts that you believe God has molded in you.
3.	Reflect on how knowing God is your potter changes your view of yourself.







## Prayer for Today

Dear Father, thank You for shaping me with care and purpose. Even when I don't understand the process, help me trust Your hands and Your plan. Mold my heart and mind to become more like Your perfect design. Teach me patience and faith as You refine me, and help me see the beauty You are creating. I rest in the knowledge that I am Your special creation, intentionally made for a purpose only You know. *Thank You for never giving up on me.* Amen.

1 Corinthians 12:4-6 - "There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work."

## Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 12:6 "We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us."
- Ephesians 4:11 "He gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers."







#### Devotional: Celebrate Your God-Given Gifts
