Your Verse

Psalm 34:18 "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 147:3 "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."
- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed... I will strengthen you and help you."







Day 1: 😭 God's Nearness in Our Pain

Devotional: God's Presence in Our Deepest Pain

Grief often brings a deep sense of loneliness and despair. In those moments, it may feel like God is distant or indifferent. Yet, Scripture gently reminds us that God is not far but intimately close to our hurting hearts.

The psalmist declares with confidence that *the Lord is close to the brokenhearted*. This promise assures us that God does not turn away from our pain but draws near, embracing our sorrow and offering healing.

Even when we feel crushed down beneath the weight of grief, God's presence is a lifeline. He intervenes not simply as a distant observer but as a caring Savior who understands our suffering deeply. - Nahum 1:7 "The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him."







Day 2: OGod Our Refuge and Strength

Devotional: Finding Strength in God Our Refuge

In times of grief, pain, and hardship, it can be difficult to find inner strength to keep moving forward. Yet God calls Himself our *refuge and strength* — a stronghold we can rely upon when all else seems to fail.

This truth invites us to rest in God's power instead of our own limited capacity. When we shelter ourselves under His protection, we gain courage and endurance beyond what we could muster alone. He is not only near but actively helping us.

Our grief may feel like a storm, but God is our fortress, steady and strong. When fear rises and tears flow, we can cry out to Him, confident He hears and will rescue us. Trusting in God's protection renews hope and empowers hearts weakened by sorrow.

Day 3: Phope Beyond the Tears

Devotional: Clinging to Hope Beyond Grief

Grieving can feel endless, but the Bible points us to a glorious promise beyond our present sorrows. In Revelation, God promises a future where pain and tears are no more—where mourning and death are swallowed up forever.

This hope is more than wishful thinking. It is a firm assurance grounded in God's faithful character and redemptive plan through Jesus Christ. Life's storms may rage, but God is preparing a new, perfect world of joy and peace.

Knowing this hope gives us strength to endure, helps us process loss with purpose, and encourages our hearts to look beyond today's pain toward eternal peace. It reminds us that grief is temporary in the light of God's eternal love.

Devotional: Experiencing God's Deep, Calming Peace

Though grief stirs turmoil within our hearts, God offers a peace that goes beyond human comprehension. *This peace stands guard over our hearts and minds*, protecting us from being overwhelmed by anxiety or despair.

God's peace is a calming presence in the storm, rooted in knowing Christ. It is not the absence of pain, but the confident assurance that God is sovereign and in control. His peace quiets the turmoil and reassures us that amid loss, we are secure in His love.

Allow this peace to settle deeply within you today. Take moments throughout the day to breathe in God's calming presence and let His peace rule your thoughts, replacing worry with trust.

2.	How can you practically invite God's peace into your daily struggles?
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3.	What difference does God's peace make compared to worldly comfort?







Journaling Prompts

1.	Write about times when God's peace surprised you in hardship.
2.	List things that cause you anxiety and surrender them to God.
3.	Describe how you can remind yourself to embrace God's peace.







Prayer for Today

Gracious God, thank You for the peace that guards my heart and mind beyond my understanding. When grief threatens to consume me with sorrow and fear, wrap me in Your comforting presence. Teach me to rest in You fully and trust Your plans even when I don't understand. May Your peace reign within me today and always. *Help me walk forward with confidence in You.* Amen.

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 66:13 "As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you."
- Matthew 5:4 "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."







Devotional: Receiving and Sharing God's Comfort

Grief is a difficult journey, but God, the source of all comfort, walks with us every step. He understands our pain and offers a compassionate embrace that soothes the deepest wounds.

Not only does God comfort us, but He also equips us to comfort others. Our own experiences allow us to empathize and extend His loving care to those who suffer. God's comfort is both healing and a call to ministry.

Today, receive God's tender comfort and reflect on how your journey might become a blessing to others. In sharing His comfort, pain is transformed into purpose.

3.	What fears or hesitations do you have about sharing your story?

1.	Write about moments you felt God comforting you deeply.

2.	List people who might benefit from your witness of God's comfort.
3.	Pray for courage and wisdom to share your comfort with others.







Prayer for Today

Comforting Father, thank You for being the God of all comfort in my troubles. I ask that You heal my broken heart and fill me with Your peace. Help me to receive Your comfort fully and to become a vessel of Your compassion to others who grieve. Teach me to walk alongside those hurting with grace and love. *Use my journey for Your glory.* Amen.

















Day 6: 1 Casting Our Cares on God

Your Verse

1 Peter 5:7 "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 55:22 "Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken."
- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."







Day 6: 1 Casting Our Cares on God

Devotional: Finding Rest by Surrendering to God

Grief can feel like a heavy burden that saps our strength. The Bible encourages us to cast all our anxieties and worries upon God because He deeply cares for us.

This verse reminds us that God invites us to surrender our pain, fears, and doubts to Him instead of holding on tightly. When we release control and entrust God with our burdens, we find rest and renewal.

Jesus calls the weary to come to Him for rest, promising relief from the overwhelming weight of grief. Today, practice actively giving your cares to God in prayer, trusting His loving hands to carry you through.

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Corinthians 5:7 "For we live by faith, not by sight."
- Hebrews 11:1 "Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."







Day 7: 🗱 Walking Forward with Faith

Devotional: Moving Forward Firmly in God's Faithfulness

Grief changes us and challenges the way we see the future. Yet God's promise assures us He walks with us through every trial, never allowing us to be overwhelmed.

The imagery of passing through waters and rivers emphasizes that though grief may feel like a flood threatening to engulf us, God's presence keeps us safe and secure. He empowers us to live by faith—trusting in Him even when our circumstances are unclear or painful.

Faith is confidence in God's goodness and a hope that transcends our sight. As you conclude this study, consider how you can continue walking forward, leaning on God's promises confidently. He is your refuge in every storm.
