#### Devotional: Start with God's Perspective on Ambition

**Ambition itself is not sinful;** it's the heart behind our ambition that matters. Proverbs 16:3 reminds us to commit our work to the Lord as the foundation for true success. When our career goals align with God's will, He promises to guide and establish our plans.

James warns about selfish ambition born out of envy — this wreaks havoc not only in our lives but in communities. In contrast, Colossians calls us to view our work as service to God, not merely to bosses or paychecks. This shifts our motivation from self-centered achievement to faithful stewardship.

*Today, ask God to reveal the nature of your ambitions.* Are they motivated by service, growth, and glorifying Him, or by competition, comparison, and personal accolades? This awareness is the first step in cultivating godly ambition.

#### Devotional: Excellence Honors God, Not Success

God calls us to pursue excellence in all our efforts. Ecclesiastes 9:10 encourages wholehearted work, reminding us that doing our best honors God's design and gifts.

Yet, the quest for excellence can sometimes slip into idolizing success—where achievements become the ultimate goal, treasured above all else. 1 Corinthians 10:31 points us back to a higher purpose: whatever we do, including work, should glorify God.

*Matthew 6:33 grounds us in priorities:* when we seek God's Kingdom first, our success will follow in the right measure and time. This perspective keeps ambition from turning into an idol and frees us to enjoy God-centered achievements without anxiety or pride.

Today, remember that excellence is honoring God, not chasing applause.

#### Devotional: Choose Humility Over Selfish Ambition

Selfish ambition breeds competition, envy, and broken relationships. Paul warns in Philippians 2:3 to avoid acting out of selfish ambition or conceit. Instead, the heart of godly ambition is humility and love.

Galatians reminds us to resist pride that sparks jealousy and division. Our career ambitions can easily become a battleground if we're not vigilant.

Romans 12:10 counters this by calling us to honor others above ourselves, promoting unity in the workplace and beyond. Guarding your heart against selfish motives requires ongoing self-examination and surrender.

Ask God daily to cleanse your motivations and cultivate humility that lifts others up rather than pushing them down.
